- (1) However, in order to honor St. Elizabeth Ann Seton with a more festive celebration befitting her as our Parish Patroness, the late Bishop Richard Garcia has approved the 2nd Sunday after the Baptism of Jesus as our perpetual parish celebration of her feast. On 2019, it falls on January 27, 2019. Our parish will have the Sat. Vigil English 5:30 pm Mass and the Sunday 9 am Bilingual Mass with procession and potluck reception. Join us on this special day!

FROM THE DIOCESE

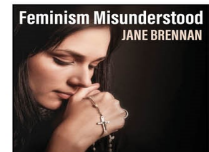
