*Today's Readings: Acts 2:1–11; Psalm 104:1, 24, 25–30, 31, 34; 1 Corinthians 12:3b–7, 12–13; John 20:19–23.* The Easter season ends with the Solemnity of Pentecost, which marks the disciples going into the world. In today's reading from Acts, the disciples are gathered in the upper room, the place where they encountered the Risen Christ and where they received the gift of his Body and Blood. Here, they receive the gift of the Holy Spirit and are empowered for the mission that Jesus has entrusted to them.

Crowds in the streets of Jerusalem understand when the disciples speak, even though the gathering consists of people from many nations. This group symbolizes the

worldwide mission of the Church. The Spirit will guide and encourage the disciples as they journey beyond Jerusalem to share the Word of God with all people.

The work of the disciples continues today. In our lives, followers of Christ are to welcome and look to the Holy Spirit for guidance as they continue to make God known. Some may be astounded at this and others bewildered. Still, we need to speak “of the mighty works of God.” Take some time in quiet and begin a prayer with “Come, Holy Spirit, come!” In your own words, request courage, strength, and a joyful spirit for carrying out your discipleship. Seek to make the Spirit a welcome guest in your prayer life.

*Lecturas del día: Hechos 2:1-11; Salmo 104:1, 24, 25-30, 31, 34; 1 Corintios 12:3b-7, 12-13; Juan 20:19-23.* El tiempo pascual termina con la solemnidad de Pentecostés, que marca la entrada de los discípulos ante el mundo. En los Hechos, los discípulos se encuentran reunidos en la sala superior, allí donde se encontraron con Cristo resucitado y donde recibieron el don de su Cuerpo y Sangre. Allí reciben el don del Espíritu Santo para facultarlos a la misión que Jesús les confió.

Las gentes llegadas a Jerusalén comprenden lo que hablan los discípulos, aunque hay allí gentes de muchas naciones. Es un grupo que simboliza la misión universal de la Iglesia. El Espíritu guiará y alentará a los discípulos

mientras viajan más allá de Jerusalén para compartir la Palabra de Dios con todas las personas.

Hoy sigue el trabajo de los discípulos. En nuestra vida, los discípulos de Cristo deben recibir y buscar al Espíritu Santo en busca de guía, a medida que siguen dando a conocer a Dios. Algunos quedarán asombrados por esto y otros desconcertados. Con todo, tenemos que hablar de “las poderosas obras de Dios”. Dese un buen tiempo de silencio y comience su oración diciendo: “¡Ven, Espíritu Santo, ven!”. Pida valentía, fuerza y alegría de espíritu para ser discípulo fiel. Procure que el Espíritu sea su Huésped más deseado en su oración cotidiana.
