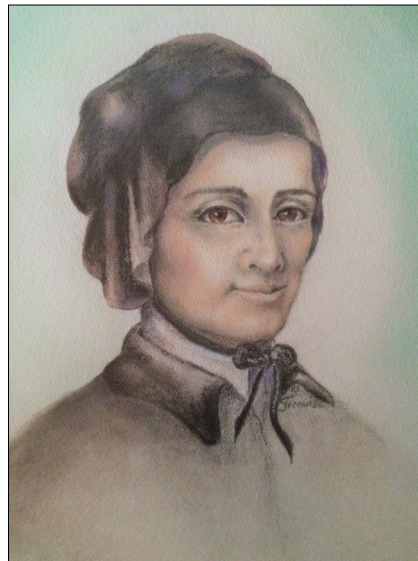

If you receive emails or texts asking you to buy gift cards from someone calling themselves "Rev. Joey R. Buena," it is a scam. Fr. Joey would NOT ask us to do anything like that.

These are both old email phishing scams according to Consumer Affairs. Please be on your guard for scams whether they are through email, text, or telephone.
