NOTE FOR DEC. 12 FEAST DAY:

1. The "Guadalupanas" is in-charge of church & hall decorations, not the Environment Committee;
2. The "Guadalupanas" helps the sponsoring state, if needed.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SPONSORING STATE:

1. BEFORE THE EVENT

- 1.1 clean & set-up church & hall;
- 1.2 decorate church & hall (note: during this event, environment committee is not in-charge of decorations);
- 1.3 provide sufficient number of roses that will be offered by the people to our Lady of Guadalupe;
- 1.4 provide plates or bowls for reception (parish provides only the napkins, cups, spoons & forks)

2. DURING THE EVENT

- 2.1 put all the roses (in a big vase with water) & novena booklets in front of main church door;
- 2.2 lead the rosary & novena prayer
- 2.3 prepare & serve food

3. AFTER THE EVENT

- 3.1 clean & restore church, hall, kitchen, bathrooms;
- 3.2 clean hall—it means sweep & mop floor, wipe tables; coffee pot washed clean;
- 3.3 clean bathroom—it means sweep floor, dry floor if wet, put waste paper in garbage;
- 3.4 clean kitchen—it means sweep & mop floor, wash sink, no food debris, dry sink;
- 3.5 trash cans are emptied of trash, new trash bags are placed;
- 3.6 clean church—it means sweep floor, align chairs, novena booklets in basket, books in shelves.
