

Turn toward the Lord




*Today's Readings: Joel 2:12–18; Psalm 51:3–4, 5–6ab, 12–13, 14 and 17; 2 Corinthians 5:20–6:2; Matthew 6:1–6, 16–18.* Today, the Church embarks on a forty-day retreat to prepare for the celebration of Easter. We join with the elect, those preparing to receive the three sacraments of initiation at Easter, in slowing down and considering the places in our lives that need to be transformed. Where has sin consumed your heart and distracted you from your relationship with God? Sin sneaks in and often becomes habit. We are invited to examine each area of our lives to uncover this darkness. We are asked to change our hearts and turn back to God. The words of the prophet Joel still ring true today. We need to repent and return to the Lord. Conversion isn't easy and

doesn't happen overnight. It requires discipline, perseverance, and practice. The three disciplines of the Lenten season, prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, help us open ourselves to God's goodness and can draw us closer to the heart of Christ. Over these forty days, allow these disciplines to become habits that replace sin, move you to reflect on your life in Christ, and immerse you in the Paschal Mystery.

In the Gospel, Jesus instructs us not to publicly flaunt how we pray, fast, or give alms. As you meditate on the words of the psalm, think about what you might give up (fast), how you will set aside time for prayer, and to what you might give alms as a way of deeply entering the season of Lent and purifying your heart.

## Miércoles, 10 de febrero de 2016 Volvámonos al Señor



Lecturas del día: *Joel 2:12–18; Salmo 51:3–4, 5–6ab, 12–13, 14 y 17; 2 Corintios 5:20–6:2; Mateo 6:1–6, 16–18*. Hoy, la Iglesia se embarca en un retiro de cuarenta días de preparación para la celebración de la Pascua. Nos unimos a los elegidos, a los que se preparan a recibir los tres sacramentos de la iniciación cristiana, para serenarnos y examinar lo que necesita ser transformado en nuestra vida. A usted, ¿dónde le ha consumido el pecado el corazón, alejándolo de Dios? El pecado se infiltra hasta hacerse hábito. Hay que examinar cada área de nuestra vida para descubrir si hay oscuridad. Las palabras del profeta Joel siguen resonando hoy. Necesitamos arrepentirnos y volvemos a Dios.

La conversión no es fácil, ni se realiza de un día a otro.

Requiere disciplina, perseverancia y práctica. Los tres ejercicios de piedad cuaresmal, oración, ayuno y limosna, nos ayudan a abrirnos a la bondad de Dios y a acercarnos al corazón de Cristo. En estos cuarenta días, haga que esas prácticas se le vuelvan hábitos para remover el pecado y lo conduzcan a reflexionar en su propia vida ante Cristo mientras lo zambullen en el misterio pascual cristiano.

En el evangelio, Jesús nos instruye a no ser ostentosos cuando oramos, ayunamos o damos limosna. Meditando en las palabras del salmo, considere lo que usted ha sacrificado (ayuno), el tiempo que dedica a orar y lo que podría dar en solidaridad, como un modo de abrazar la Cuaresma y purificar su corazón.
