


2015 SEMINARIAN & CONTINUING EDUCATION OF PRIESTS SECOND COLLECTION ON SEP.19-20

The second collection for Seminarian and Continuing Education of Priests is **September 19-20**.

We are blessed with 16 men who have accepted the call to discern and prepare for the priesthood, as well as many amazing and dedicated priests currently providing spiritual nourishment in our parishes. As a faithful community, we must make supporting the education of our future priests and pastors a priority.

The decision to pursue God's call and enter the seminary is an expensive one. The rich, complex education provided to seminarians is grounded in biblical study, Catholic Tradition, historical perspective, worship practice and theology. The diocese bears the cost of tuition, room and board for our seminarians – at \$40,000 per year, per seminarian, that equates to a \$640,000 yearly investment in the sacramental life of every adult and child in our diocese for generations to come.


