

MASS REMINDERS

- The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation issued on March 12, 2020, is still in effect until further notice.
- 2) Even with the resumption of public liturgies, parishioners who are particularly vulnerable should be urged to remain home (e.g. over the age of sixty, have an existing heart or lung conditions. diabetes, or are otherwise immunocompromised). Such individuals should not volunteer or be asked to volunteer to fulfill liturgical ministries. Likewise, parishioners who feel sick in any way, those with a fever or cough, and those who live with a person found to be positive for COVID-19, should be urged to refrain from public gatherings, including liturgical celebrations, until a doctor determines it is safe for them to do so.



NOVEMBER 6TH/7TH

Our roofing company is Bean's Roofing. There is a known leak in the roof. Because their work is under warranty, a scheduled repair is to be made. On October 26th roofing material arrived and was placed by a very large truck on the church roof for the repair to be made. The rain during the night between Fri Nov 6th and Sat Nov 7th brought a little needed rain to Los Osos. With the leak in the roof, water that night came into the church, running down the interior wall between stain glass windows and caused the paint at the top of the wall over one of the stain glass windows to bubble. Additional water damage occurred around the lights in the central ceiling toward the entrance. We are still waiting for our roofing company to do the repairs.

Much appreciation to our office manager, Javier Soto Osorio, for his quick response and clean-up of the water on the floors in the aisle and close to nearby pews before parishioners arrived for the 9:00 am 1st Saturday Mass and Rosary.

Bean's Roofing has apologized for any inconvenience and says if the repairs are not made before the next rain they will place a tarp over the roof to protect the church roof.
