Jesus immediately reassures them with words that should constantly accompany our lives and our vocational journey: 'Take heart, it is I; have no fear' (Mt 14:27)".

The Office of Vocations from the Diocese of Monterey invites all Catholics to grow in the awareness of vocations to priesthood, diaconate, and consecrated life, during the National Vocation Awareness Week. The NVAW is an annual week-long celebration of the Catholic Church in the United States dedicated to promote vocations through prayer and education, and to renew our prayers and support for those who are considering one of these particular vocations.

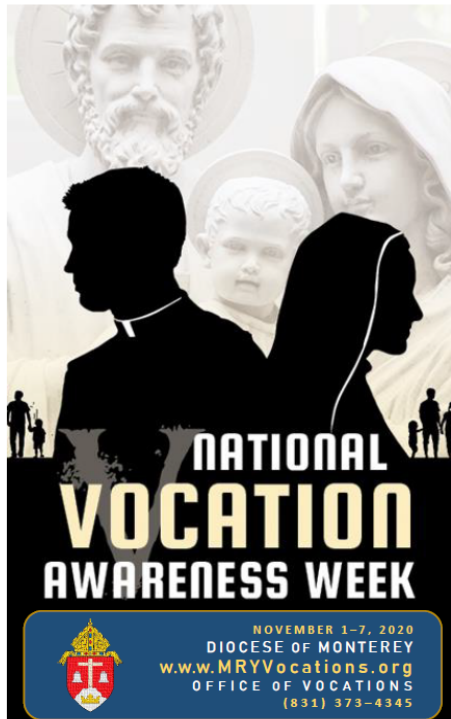

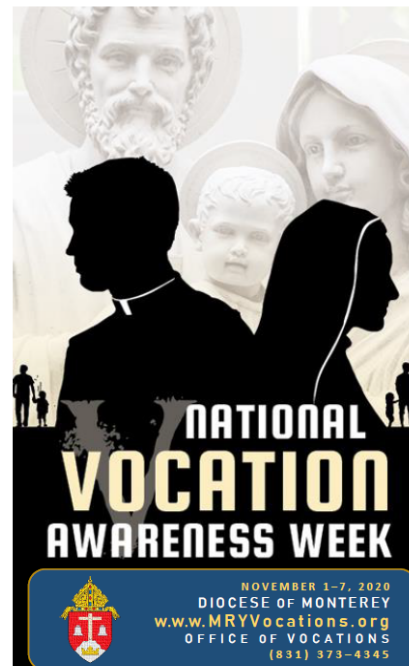
¿A DÓNDE TE LLAMA DIOS? Una vocación es un llamado continuo de Dios para compartir su amor.

- ❖ **Matrimonio** – la vocación natural de todo hombre y mujer es el matrimonio. Las personas casadas se comprometen a “un consorcio de toda la vida, ordenado por su misma índole natural al bien de los cónyuges y a la generación y educación de la prole por Cristo Nuestro Señor a la dignidad de sacramento entre bautizados.” (CCC 1601)
- ❖ **Vida Religiosa** – algunos hombres y mujeres están llamados a una consagración más profunda de sus vidas a Dios. Las hermanas religiosas prometen vivir solo para Dios a través de la pobreza, la castidad y la obediencia. Jesús recomendó esta vida como un medio para comprometerse seguramente con Dios, y a través de esta forma de vida, los religiosos son llamados al trabajo de construir el Reino de Dios mediante sus oraciones y trabajo.
- ❖ **Órdenes Sagrados** – “El Orden Sagrado es el sacramento gracias al cual la misión confiada por Cristo a sus Apóstoles se ejerce en la Iglesia hasta el fin de los tiempos: es, pues, el sacramento del ministerio apostólico. Comprende tres grados: el presbiterado y el diaconado.” (CCC 1536) El sacerdocio es un ministerio de llevar a Jesús a las personas y a las comunidades a través de la enseñanza y los sacramentos.
- ❖ **Vida Sagrada de Soltero** – algunas personas sirven a Dios como solteros, sin casarse ni tomar votos especiales. Las personas solteras sirven a la Iglesia de una manera significativa. Las personas solteras “pueden contribuir grandemente al bien de la Iglesia.” (CCC 2231) “Hay quienes viven su situación según el espíritu de las bienaventuranzas sirviendo a Dios y al prójimo de una manera especial.” (CCC 1658) En algunas circunstancias, las personas solteras hacen una consagración formal bajo su obispo local.

WHERE IS GOD CALLING YOU? A vocation is a continuing call from God to share His love.

- ❖ **Marriage** – The natural vocation of all men and women is marriage. Married people commit to “a partnership of the whole of life, in which the spouses are ordered toward the good of the spouses and the procreation and education of offspring; this covenant between baptized persons has been raised by Christ the Lord to the dignity of a sacrament.” (CCC 1601)
- ❖ **Religious Life** – Some men and women are called to a deeper consecration of their lives to God. Religious brothers and sisters vow to live for God alone through poverty, chastity and obedience. Jesus recommended this way of life as a means of committing oneself surely to God, and through this way of life, Religious are free to do the work of building God's Kingdom by their prayers and work.
- ❖ **Holy Orders** – “Holy Orders is the sacrament through which the mission entrusted by Christ to his apostles continues to be exercised in the church until the end of time: thus it is the sacrament of apostolic ministry. It includes three degrees: episcopate, presbyterate, and diaconate.” (CCC 1536) The priesthood is a ministry of bringing Jesus to people, and people to Jesus, especially through teaching and the Sacraments.
- ❖ **Sacred Single Life** – Some people serve God as single people, without marrying or taking special vows, but nonetheless serving the Church in a meaningful way. Single people “contribute greatly to the good of the human family.” (CCC 2231) “Some live their situation in the spirit of the Beatitudes, serving God and neighbor in exemplary fashion.” (CCC 1658) In some circumstances, single people make a formal consecration under their local bishop.

MASS TIME & VENUE CHANGES

Based on darkness, season changes, availability of disinfectants, and comments from many of you, our parish Liturgy Committee with Fr. Joey has determined to move some Mass times and to hold some Masses outdoors.

- 1) Saturday Evening Mass will be at **4:00pm** starting October 24th. Please see pg8 for Mass Schedule.
- 2) English Weekend Masses will be both indoor and outdoor depending on the week of the month and feast day. This will begin the weekend of October 24/25 with outdoor Masses for that weekend.

3) Mass on popular Feast Day, like All Saints, (well-attended in the past) may also be done outdoor.

4) As per the request of many in our Hispanic Community and due to many in-person attendees at the number at Mass, all weekend Spanish Masses will be outdoors.

5) In case of heavy rain on the days that we are to have outdoor Masses, the Mass will be livestreamed for our parishioners to view at home. We will not come to church those days. Due to the pandemic the dispensation from Bishop Danny is still in effect i.e. you do not commit a sin when you are not in Mass in-person.

6) Venue schedule will always be posted in our weekly bulletin and on our parish website. Please make it a habit to check our parish bulletin and website.

7) If the County reverts to 'tier 1' or 'purple' or widespread COVID Cases, all liturgies automatically revert to outdoors only.

MASS REMINDERS

- 1) The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation issued on March 12, 2020, is still in effect until further notice.
- 2) Even with the resumption of public liturgies, parishioners who are particularly vulnerable should be urged to remain home (e.g. over the age of sixty, have an existing heart or lung conditions, diabetes, or are otherwise immuno-compromised). Such individuals should not volunteer or be asked to volunteer to fulfill liturgical ministries. Likewise, parishioners who feel sick in any way, those with a fever or cough, and those who live with a person found to be positive for COVID-19, should be urged to refrain from public gatherings, including liturgical celebrations, until a doctor determines it is safe for them to do so.
- 3) Even with the return to Mass, we know that many of our parishioners will continue to join with us virtually through continued Mass on our parish YouTube Channel, parish website, and Facebook.
- 4) To register for daily Mass or returning to weekend Mass, please contact the office at seaschurchlo@gmail.com or call 805-235-8803. **You need to register for each Mass.** Thanks!

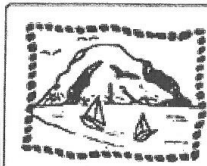
