## BACK TO OUTDOOR MASSES

This past Monday, November 16th our county reverted to the Purple Tier 1 signifying widespread COVID infection. Only outdoor Masses are now allowed.

## MASS REMINDERS

- 1) The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation issued on March 12, 2020, is still in effect until further notice.
- 2) Even with the resumption of public liturgies, parishioners who are particularly vulnerable should be urged to remain home (e.g. over the age of sixty, have an existing heart or lung conditions, diabetes, or are otherwise immuno-compromised). Such individuals should not volunteer or be asked to volunteer to fulfill liturgical ministries. Likewise, parishioners who feel sick in any way, those with a fever or cough, and those who live with a person found to be positive for COVID-19, should be urged to refrain from public gatherings, including liturgical celebrations, until a doctor determines it is safe for them to do so.
- 3) Even with the return to Mass, we know that many of our parishioners will continue to join with us virtually through continued Mass on our parish website, and Facebook, and YouTube channel.
- 4) To register for weekend Drive-in Mass, please contact the office at seaschurchlo@gmail.com or call 805-235-8803. **You need to register for each Mass and must receive a confirmation message.** Thanks!
- 5) Weekend Liturgy aids and the S.E.A.S. parish bulletin will continue to be emailed to parishioners whose email we have. (To add your name, just send an email to the office email.) They are also available on the parish website and MyParishApp.

# SOLEMNITY OF CHRIST THE KING

The Solemnity of Christ the King was instituted by Pope Pius XI with the encyclical *Quas primas*. The Holy Father speaks directly to the problem of what he referred to as “anti-clericalism,” by which he meant the attitude of those who were seeking to extirpate Christian influence from political life. We see a version of anti-clericalism today, for example, when it is suggested that belief in Catholic teachings renders a person unfit for a judicial appointment.

When our nation is beset by civic unrest, racial tension, and a pandemic, we do well to turn to Our Lord, who reigns over every people and nation.

## Jesus is the Word of God made flesh, the Incarnate Lord.

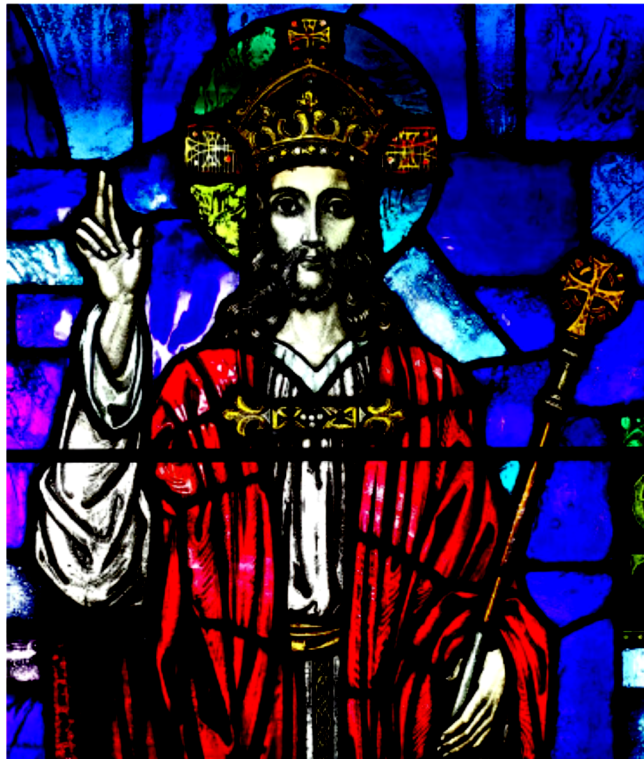
“His kingship is founded upon the ineffable hypostatic union. From this it follows not only that Christ is to be adored by angels and men, but that to him as man angels and men are subject, and must recognize his empire; by reason of the hypostatic union Christ has power over all creatures.” –*Quas primas*, 13

Jesus is fully God and fully man. He is both the divine Lord and the man who suffered and died on the Cross. In him, one person of the Trinity unites himself to human nature and reigns over all creation as the Incarnate Son of God.

## Jesus shares a law of charity to show the way to communion with God.

“Not only do the gospels tell us that he made laws, but they present him to us in the act of making them. Those who keep them show their love for their Divine Master, and he promises that they shall remain in his love.” –*Quas primas*, 14

By being close to sisters and brothers who are suffering, we draw close to Jesus. We Catholics, as individuals and as parishes, can look for



opportunities to minister to the needs of people who are hurting and, by doing so, we will be acknowledging the kingship of Christ.

## The Church acknowledges the reign of Christ, not only privately, but publicly.

“Thus by sermons preached at meetings and in churches, by public adoration of the Blessed Sacrament exposed and by solemn processions, men unite in paying homage to Christ, whom God has given them for their King.” –*Quas primas*, 26

Today, religious freedom for many people means that we can believe whatever we want, but when we enter the public square or the marketplace, we must conform to secularist orthodoxy. For Christians, when our faith is repeatedly marginalized in public life, we can fall into the habit of compartmentalizing our lives. We love Jesus in our private lives, but we shrink from acknowledging the kingship of Christ in social life. When we celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King, we declare to the world and remind ourselves that Jesus is the Lord, not only of the Church, but of the universe.

# SOLEMNIDAD DE CRISTO REY

La Solemnidad de Cristo Rey fue instituida por el Papa Pío XI con la encíclica *Quas primas*. El Santo Padre habla directamente del problema de lo que llamó "laicismo", por el cual se refería a la actitud de quienes buscaban extirpar la influencia cristiana de la vida política. Vemos un tipo de laicismo hoy, por ejemplo, cuando se sugiere que creer en la doctrina católica hace que una persona no sea apta para un nombramiento judicial.

Cuando nuestra nación está atacada por disturbios sociales, tensión racial y una pandemia, hacemos bien en recurrir a Nuestro Señor, que reina sobre todos los pueblos y naciones.

## Jesús es el Verbo de Dios hecho carne, el Señor Encarnado.

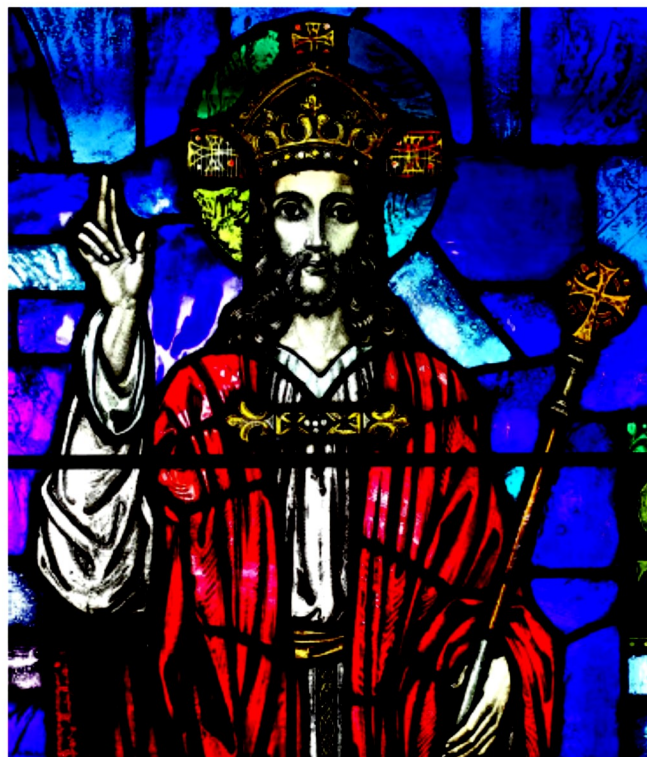
"La soberanía o principado de Cristo se funda en la maravillosa unión llamada hipostática. De donde se sigue que Cristo no sólo debe ser adorado en cuanto Dios por los ángeles y por los hombres, sino que, además, los unos y los otros están sujetos a su imperio y le deben obedecer también en cuanto hombre; de manera que por el solo hecho de la unión hipostática, Cristo tiene potestad sobre todas las criaturas." –*Quas primas*, 11

Jesús es plenamente Dios y plenamente hombre. Es al mismo tiempo el Señor divino y el hombre que padeció y murió en la Cruz. En él, una persona de la Santísima Trinidad se une a la naturaleza humana a través de la Encarnación y reina sobre toda la creación como el Hijo Encarnado de Dios.

## Jesús comparte una ley de caridad para mostrar el camino hacia la comunión con Dios.

"Los santos Evangelios no sólo narran que Cristo legisló, sino que nos lo presentan legislando. En diferentes circunstancias y con diversas expresiones dice el Divino Maestro que quienes guarden sus preceptos demostrarán que le aman y permanecerán en su caridad." –*Quas primas*, 13

Al estar cerca de los hermanos y hermanas que sufren, nos acercamos a Jesús. Nosotros, los



católicos, en forma individual o con la parroquia, podemos buscar oportunidades para atender las necesidades de personas que sufren y, al hacerlo, reconoceremos el reinado de Cristo.

## La Iglesia reconoce el reino de Cristo en el ámbito privado y también en el público.

"Por medio de discursos en las asambleas y en los templos, de la adoración, en común, del augusto Sacramento públicamente expuesto y de solemnísimas procesiones, proclamar a Cristo como Rey que nos ha sido dado por el cielo." –*Quas primas*, 27

Hoy, la libertad religiosa para muchas personas significa que podemos creer cualquier cosa que queramos, pero cuando entramos en la plaza o el mercado público, tenemos que adoptar la ortodoxia secular. Para los cristianos, cuando nuestra fe es marginada repetidamente en la vida pública, podemos caer en el hábito de compartimentar nuestras vidas. Amamos a Jesús en privado, pero nos abstenemos de reconocer la soberanía de Cristo en la vida social. Cuando celebramos la Solemnidad de Cristo el Rey, declaramos al mundo y nos recordamos a nosotros mismos que Jesús es el Señor, no sólo de la Iglesia, sino del universo.

Dear Hispanic Parishioners, Parents and Friends:

God's Love and Peace be with you all!

We love our Lady of Guadalupe very much, and every year we celebrate it with great festivity! Unfortunately, due to the pandemic this year and our county's revert to the "purple level" last November 16," we will celebrate her fiesta in a much simpler way. This does not mean that we love her less. It does not also mean that we believe in God less. Our Blessed Mother Mary would agree that for this year all her children must celebrate her feast in the safest manner possible. No mother would allow her children to be in danger and get sick with the deadly combination of flu and COVID-19. Because of this, as your pastor and president of the Guadalupanas, with the safety directives of Bishop Garcia as a guide, and following the county and the State rules, our parish celebration will be done as follows:

1. The novena will start on Wednesday evening of December 2 and end on Thursday evening of December 10.
2. We will celebrate the Feast Day Mass in the afternoon (before dark) of December 11 and not December 12 (see number 4 below and number 10 on the next page).
3. All novenas will be done in the safety of your own home and not inside the church building. Your family will prepare your home altar for our Lady of Guadalupe. Using any prayer guide you have, the father and the mother (or head of the household, or elder) will lead the novena. The children should join this prayer. Your family may offer flowers. After the novena, your family concludes with your usual dinner, but this time the meal is in honor of our Lady of Guadalupe. If you like, you may post a photo of your family celebration on FaceBook.
4. There will be only one (1) Feast Day Mass, and it will be on December 11, Friday, at 4:30 pm. It will be a Drive-In Mass in the big parking area. Due to the expected high number of in-person attendees, I strictly require a confirmed reservation for the 44 parking spaces. Please call Heather at 1 (805) 235-8803 or email her at [seaschurchlo@gmail.com](mailto:seaschurchlo@gmail.com). If you fail to reserve, and you arrive with no parking space available, you have to park on Palisades Avenue.
5. At this Feast Day Mass, please bring your roses. During the Offertory, you will offer roses as a family, walk to the altar, one vehicle at a time,



Estimados feligreses, padres y amigos hispanos:

¡El Amor y la Paz de Dios sean con todos ustedes!

¡Amamos mucho a nuestra Señora de Guadalupe y cada año la celebramos con gran festividad! Desafortunadamente, debido a la pandemia de este año y nuestro condado volvió al "nivel púrpura" el pasado 16 de Noviembre," celebraremos su fiesta de una manera mucho más sencilla. Esto no significa que la amemos menos. Tampoco significa que creemos menos en Dios. Nuestra Santísima Madre María estaría de acuerdo en que para este año todos sus hijos deben celebrar su fiesta de la manera más segura posible. Ninguna madre permitiría que sus hijos estuvieran en peligro y se enfermaran de la mortal combinación de gripe y COVID-19. Por eso, como su párroco y presidente de las Guadalupanas, con las directivas de seguridad del Obispo García como guía, y siguiendo las reglas del condado y del Estado, nuestra celebración parroquial se realizará de la siguiente manera:

1. La novena comenzará el Miércoles 2 de Diciembre por la noche y terminará el Jueves 10 de Diciembre por la noche.
2. Celebraremos su Misa de Fiesta por la tarde (antes del anochecer) el 11 de Diciembre y no el 12 de Diciembre (ver los números 4 y 9 a continuación).
3. Todas las novenas se realizarán en la seguridad de su hogar y no dentro del edificio de la iglesia. Su familia preparará el altar de su casa para Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe. Usando cualquier guía de oración que tenga, el padre y la madre (o el jefe de familia o el anciano) dirigirán la novena. Los niños deben unirse a esta oración. Su familia puede ofrecer flores. Después de la novena, su familia concluye con su cena habitual, pero esta vez la comida es en honor a Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe. Si lo desea, puede publicar una foto de su celebración familiar en FaceBook.
4. Habrà solo una, (1) Misa de Fiesta, y será el Viernes 11 de Diciembre a las 4:30 pm. Será una Misa en el estacionamiento. Debido al alto número esperado de asistentes en persona, requiero estrictamente una reservación confirmada para los 44 espacios. On early Saturday morning of December 12, parents and children will sing your <u>Mañanita to our Lady of Guadalupe at your home altar</u>, concluding it with your family breakfast.</p> <p>7. <u>On December 12, 6 pm, parents will lead the Holy Rosary at your own home.</u> Your children should pray with you. The prayer intentions are:</p> <p>(1) For the good health and protection from the deadly flu and COVID-19 of your family &amp; parish community.  (2) For the intentions of Pope Francis.  (3) For the conversion of sinners and peace in the world.</p> <p>After the praying of the Holy Rosary, your family may celebrate a festive dinner in honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe.</p> <p>8. For your health and safety, please avoid placing your family at high risk of getting sick by combining several family celebrations in one home. The decision is yours.</p> <p>9. Because of safety reasons, health issues of ministers and volunteers, logistics, and financial difficulties, we will NOT be able to do our following traditional activities: early morning Mañanita, procession with Rosary before Mass, community reception after Mass, and all activities within the church building.</p> <p>10. We cannot celebrate the Feast Day Mass on the Saturday morning of December 12 because most of you are at work. We cannot celebrate it on late afternoon of December 12 because Church Liturgy after 3:00 pm allows us to celebrate only the Third Sunday of Advent. The Feast Day Mass on the late afternoon of December 11 is called "Vigil." 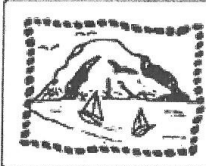
