LITANY OF THE SACRED HEART WITH ARCHBISHOP JOSE GOMEZ ON GOOD FRIDAY

Our Archbishop José H. Gomez of Los Angeles and president of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops invites us to join him in prayer:

"On Good Friday, on behalf of the bishops in the United States, I will pray the Litany of the Sacred Heart of Jesus for an end to the coronavirus pandemic. I ask you to join me in this prayer, which will be livestreamed over the internet at 9 a.m. on the West Coast and 12 noon on the East Coast. Let us join as one family of God here in the United States in asking our Lord for his mercy."

*"The Holy Father has granted a **special plenary indulgence** to those who pray for an end to this pandemic. To receive this indulgence, you need to pray the Litany of the Sacred Heart on Good Friday, be truly sorry for your sins and desire to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation as soon as it is possible, and you need to pray for the intentions of the Pope. In the heart of Jesus, pierced as he hung on the cross on Good Friday, we see the love of God for humanity, his love for each one of us."* <https://lacatholics.org/sacred-heart/> or on Facebook.

HOLY THURSDAY PILGRIMAGES

There is a tradition of visiting 7 churches on Holy Thursday. The Seven Churches Visitation grew out of the tradition of prayer and adoration based on the number of places or 'stations' that Jesus stopped between the Last Supper and his Crucifixion.

The seven stations consist of: Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane (Luke 22: 39-46), Jesus bound and taken before Annas (John 18: 19-22), Jesus taken before the High Priest, Caiaphas (Matthew 26: 63-65), Jesus taken before Pilate (John 18, 35-37), Jesus taken before Herod (Luke 23: 8-9; 11), Jesus taken before Pilate again (Matthew 27: 22-26) and Jesus given the crown of thorns and led to his crucifixion (Matthew 27: 27-31). These are read and a prayer said in Adoration at each stop. This year, instead of traveling, we can do a virtual pilgrimage.

HOLY WEEK

From the Ordo:

Palm Sunday: "The Church recalls the entrance of Christ the Lord into Jerusalem to accomplish the Paschal Mystery" (p94)... "Jesus, humbled himself out of love for us, did not shield his face from buffets and spitting, but offered his life on the cross" (p95)

Spy Wednesday: "Jesus speaks of his betrayal which is at hand." (p95)

Holy or Maundy Thursday: "Lent ends before the Evening Prayer is celebrated. The Easter Triduum begins with the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper, ending with the conclusion of Vespers on Easter Sunday.

The Sacred Paschal Triduum

Since Christ his work of human redemption and of the perfect glorification of God principally through his Paschal Mystery, in which by dying he has destroyed our death, and by rising restored our life, the sacred Paschal Triduum of the Passion and Resurrection of the Lord shines forth as the high point of the entire liturgical year." (p95)

Good Friday: "Entrusting his life to the Father, Jesus bore our infirmities, and, obedient unto death, won for us eternal salvation."

Today, Good Friday, and if possible, on Holy Saturday until the Easter Vigil, the **paschal fast** is observed everywhere to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus, and to prepare ourselves to share more deeply in his resurrection" (p101)

CELEBRATING VIRTUAL LITURGIES AS A FAMILY

PREPARE

Dress up the table around the device you will be using. Use appropriate liturgical colors (purple is for Lent, white is for Easter, and green is for ordinary time). Also place a candle, Bible and crucifix next to your device. Set up your chairs as if you were in a chapel.

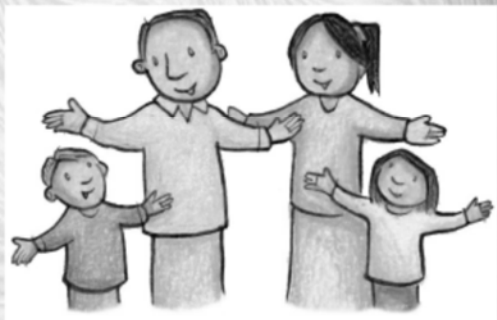
Don't forget to get dressed! Participating in liturgy is different than watching television. Although it is okay to watch a movie in your pajamas, effort on our appearance helps us to know this is important.



CELEBRATE

Although there may not be doughnuts, fix your family's favorite meal, like pancakes. Around the table reflect on the Word and homily.

Talk about something your family can do to help those in need. Maybe an elderly neighbor needs help with shopping, or there is a project you can do as a family. Maybe there is a charity like Catholic Charities or Catholic Relief Services you can donate to.

WORSHIP

Engage! Sing, respond, and pray together. Stand, sit and kneel at the appropriate time. Pay special attention to the Prayers of the Faithful and respond, "Lord, hear our prayer". Add your own intentions in your heart. When it comes time for communion say a prayer. Remember that we are in solidarity with parts of the world where weekly communion is not possible. (See prayer for spiritual communion below.)

Don't forget the collection! You can give every week by donating through the Diocesan or parish's web site. It is import to continue your giving so that wages and bills can be paid!

WHAT IS SPIRITUAL COMMUNION?

A spiritual communion is a uniting of oneself to the Sacrifice of the Mass through prayer, and can be made whether one is able to receive Communion or not.

Pain is magnified because of the many restrictions due to the pandemic. Any public gathering (Rosary, Funeral Mass or Memorial Mass, reception) is not allowed in our parish church at this time.

There will only be a Graveside Service (Rite of Committal & Final Commendation) with Fr. Joey the only one allowed to be near the casket. Limited number of immediate family members will be allowed to watch from afar. Passengers of each vehicle will be allowed to approach the grave, one group at a time, to say goodbye.
