2) Some families have asked about the Sacraments of 1st Communion and Confirmation for this year and whether they will take place as scheduled. We know that this is a stressful time for everyone. Our parish, like the others in the Diocese, is taking its cues from Bishop Garcia, who is deeply concerned about the reception of the Sacraments by the Faithful.

When the government lifts the stay in place order and other restrictions, then our diocese will be able to implement its plan for the Sacraments. Please know that things probably won't immediately go back to the way they used to be.

Until restrictions are lifted, we must, as the Body of Christ, be patient and offer our sufferings, this waiting, and uncertainty to Christ by laying them at the foot of his Cross that they may be transformed into something beautiful within us.

## PRAYING THE ROSARY WITH POPE FRANCIS

Pope Francis in his May letter to the world encourages us to pray to Our Lady through the Rosary and gives us these prayers to pray at the end of the Rosary, saying he too will be praying them and through them we are in solidarity. He sends his blessings to all. (Vatican News Apr 25, 2020)

### FIRST PRAYER

O Mary, You shine continuously on our journey as a sign of salvation and hope. We entrust ourselves to you, Health of the Sick, who, at the foot of the cross, were united with Jesus' suffering, and persevered in your faith. "Protectress of the Roman people", you know our needs, and we know that you will provide, so that, as at Cana in Galilee, joy and celebration may return after this time of trial. Help us, Mother of Divine Love, to conform ourselves to the will of the Father and to do what Jesus tells us. For he took upon himself our suffering, and burdened himself with our sorrows to bring us, through the cross, to the joy of the Resurrection. Amen.

*We fly to your protection, O Holy Mother of God; Do not despise our petitions in our necessities, but deliver us always from every danger, O Glorious and Blessed Virgin.*

### SECOND PRAYER

"We fly to your protection, O Holy Mother of God". In the present tragic situation, when the whole world is prey to suffering and anxiety, we fly to you, Mother of God and our Mother, and seek refuge under your protection.

Virgin Mary, turn your merciful eyes towards us amid this coronavirus pandemic. Be close to those who assist the sick night and day, and to priests who, in their pastoral concern and fidelity to the Gospel, are trying to help and support everyone.

Blessed Virgin, illumine the minds of men and women engaged in scientific research, that they may find effective solutions to overcome this virus.

Support national leaders, that with wisdom, solicitude and generosity they may come to the aid of those lacking the basic necessities of life and may devise social and economic solutions inspired by farsightedness and solidarity.

Mary Most Holy, stir our consciences, so that the enormous funds invested in developing and stockpiling arms will instead be spent on promoting effective research on how to prevent similar tragedies from occurring in the future.

Beloved Mother, help us realize that we are all members of one great family and to recognize the bond that unites us, so that, in a spirit of fraternity and solidarity, we can help to alleviate countless situations of poverty and need. Make us strong in faith, persevering in service, constant in prayer.

Mary, Consolation of the afflicted, embrace all your children in distress and pray that God will stretch out his all-powerful hand and free us from this terrible pandemic, so that life can serenely resume its normal course.

## MAY, THE MONTH OF MARY

Marian devotion has been in Catholic Tradition since the Early Church. The Mother of God is known by many titles.

In the 13th Century, Alfonso X of Castile wrote the Cantigas de Santa Maria which mentions the special devotions to Mary in May. Throughout the centuries Marian devotions in May continued and include special prayers, procession with statues or other images, family altars, May crowning of Our Lady, etc.

Our Lady appeared to three children in Fatima, Portugal beginning on May 13, 1917 (Feast Day of Our Lady of Fatima) and made known in newspapers and radio around the world.

Pope Pius XII encouraged a family home altar where the recitation of the family Rosary could be said communally, especially in May, in his encyclical, *Ingruentum malorum*, of 1951.



On Easter 2020 the Conference of Latin American Bishops and the Caribbean reconsecrated their nations to Our Lady of Guadalupe, as she is known to some. On May 1st, 2020 the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops and those in Canada reconsecrated our nations to Our Lady.

Above is a recent photo of the statue of Mary in the prayer garden outside our parish office. The angels have scrolls on which are inscribed "Faith", "Hope", and "Love."

## HOW TO PRAY THE ROSARY

1. Holding the crucifix, make the sign of the cross AND pray the **Apostles' Creed**
2. On the first bead, pray the **Our Father**.
3. Pray one **Hail Mary** on each of the next three beads, one for *Faith*, one for *Hope*, and one for *Charity*.
4. Pray the **Gloria Be**.
5. Announce the first mystery and pray the **Our Father**.
6. Pray the **Hail Mary** on each of the next 10 beads while meditating on the Mystery.
7. Pray the **Gloria Be** to end the first decade. After finishing each decade, pray the **Fatima Decade Prayer** as requested by the Blessed Virgin Mary at Fatima.
8. After saying the five decades, say the **Salve Regina (Hail, Holy Queen)**, followed by this dialogue and prayer:

*V. Pray for us, O holy Mother of God.  
R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.*

*Let us pray. O God, whose only-begotten Son, by his life, death, and Resurrection, has purchased for us the rewards of eternal life, grant, we beseech you, that meditating on these mysteries of the most holy rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we may imitate what they contain and obtain what they promise, through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.*

### Fatima Prayer:

*O My Jesus, forgive us our sins. Save us from the fires of hell, take all souls to Heaven, especially those in most need of Thy mercy.*

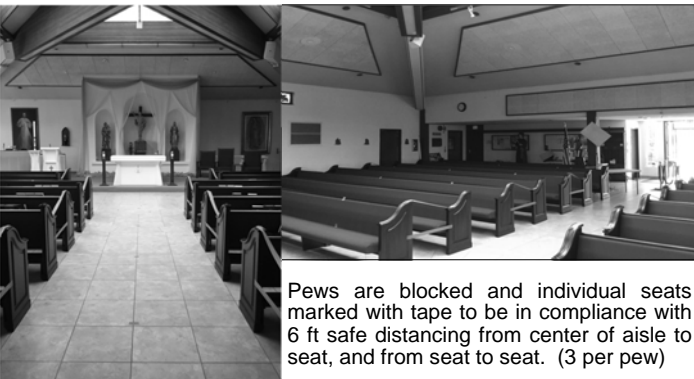

## SOCIAL DISTANCING AT S.E.A.S. DUE TO COVID-19

In the future, restrictions for the 'Stay in Place' orders due to the COVID 19 virus will be lifted gradually, but social distancing will still be in effect. As a parish we will also need to make adjustments. The logistics are still being worked out. However, these things are certain: We need to be prepared to only enter through one door and exit through the doors marked 'exit'; We will all be wearing masks; Hand sanitizer usage will be routine for all; We will be sitting six feet apart; Attendance per Mass will be limited; if anyone feels sick or has symptoms of a cold, out of charity for others, they should remain home.

We joyfully anticipate the return to communal Mass and have begun the physical preparations. (See photos below)

During the coming months we will work together as a community to safeguard the health of all our parishioners, to support each other spiritually and in the daily necessities, and to continue sacrificing and praying not because of the virus, but due to our intense love for each other inspired by the Holy Spirit.

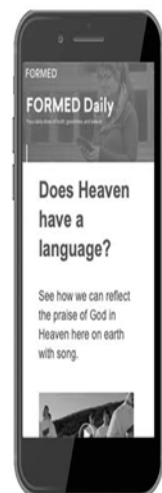
