MASS REMINDERS

- The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation issued on March 12, 2020, is still in effect until further notice.
- 2) Even with the resumption of public liturgies, parishioners who are particularly vulnerable should be urged to remain home (e.g. over the age of sixty, have an existing heart or lung conditions, diabetes, or are otherwise immuno-compromised). Such individuals should not volunteer or be asked to volunteer to fulfill liturgical ministries. Likewise, parishioners who feel sick in any way, those with a fever or cough, and those who live with a person found to be positive for COVID-19, should be urged to refrain from public gatherings, including liturgical celebrations, until a doctor determines it is safe for them to do so.
- 3) Even with the return to Mass, we know that many of our parishioners will continue to join with us virtually through continued Mass on our parish YouTube Channel, parish website, and Facebook.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION



Our first week and a half of Masses have taught our parish Liturgy Committee and our Office Staff a great deal!

We learned how long it takes in general to prepare the church and to sanitize it before and after masses.


We learned that our liturgical ministers are still ready to serve. Training of Lectors in regard to health safety measures has already begun and will continue as ministers return. Our EMs will wait for retraining until accessories to be used in Mass have arrived in July.

We learned that we need to be open to changes. Our first weekend brought tech challenges, fluctuations in temperatures and strong winds especially at the Spanish Mass. The outdoor altar appearance reflected these factors from Mass to Mass last weekend.

We learned that even though something looks convenient, it does not mean that it is a good idea. Case in point, we thought we could have Mass inside the church for Saturday evening since attendance was low the first week, however we discovered that several parishioners felt more comfortable at the parking lot Mass and cancelled their attendance for the indoor Saturday Mass. That coupled with the natural heat of the church for the Friday liturgy prompted the change of venue for Sat. June 20th Mass to be returned to the parking lot. This means all our weekend Masses will be in the large parking lot for the time being.

We learned the importance of having parishioners register for each Mass that they will attend instead of rolling the names to the next week. Thank you to everyone for calling or emailing daily/weekly to register for daily and weekend Masses. We also remind parishioners that if you make a reservation and can't attend, please notify the office so that another person may have your space.

We had reiterated to us what it is to serve within our parish and the love that we share as a parish community. May God bless you. Stay safe.
