CONTINUED PRAYERS DURING COVID-19

Let us continue to pray for first responders, essential workers, those on our Prayer Request List, those who have died from the COVID 19 virus and their loved ones.

As COVID numbers in our area rise, families may be dealing with financial stress, and health-safety guidelines and restrictions remain in places, we may hear people ask, 'Where is God?' or 'Why does God let bad things happen?'

"God is infinitely good and all his works are good. Yet no one can escape the experience of suffering or the evils in nature which seem to be linked to the limitations proper to creatures: and above all to the question of moral evil. Where does evil come from? "I sought whence evil comes and there was no solution", said St. Augustine, and his own painful quest would only be resolved by his conversion to the living God. For "the mystery of lawlessness" is clarified only in the light of the "mystery of our religion"." (Catechism of the Catholic Church aka CCC #385)

"God did not make death, and he does not delight in the death of the living. . . It was through the devil's envy that death entered the world", (CCC #413; Wis 1:13; 2:24)

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son." (Jn 3:16)

MASS REMINDERS

- The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation issued on March 12, 2020, is still in effect until further notice.
- Even with the resumption of public liturgies, parishioners who are particularly vulnerable should be urged to remain home (e.g. over the age of sixty, have an existing heart or lung conditions, diabetes, or are otherwise immuno-compromised). Such individuals should not volunteer or be asked to volunteer to fulfill liturgical ministries. Likewise, parishioners who feel sick in any way, those with a fever or cough, and those who live with a person found to be positive for COVID-19, should be urged to refrain from public gatherings, including liturgical celebrations, until a doctor determines it is safe for them to do so.
- 3) Even with the return to Mass, we know that many of our parishioners will continue to join with us virtually through continued Mass on our parish YouTube Channel, parish website, and Facebook.

With Great Appreciation

Our parish is grateful to our parishioner family for reaching out to Fr. Joey for the donation of the tabor for Adoration.

'What is a tabor?' you may ask. Tabor is the name of the stand used for Adoration when the Blessed Eucharist is displayed. The name 'tabor' helps us to understand and reminds us of what is happening.

Adoration:
First, Adoration is the practice of adoring the Blessed Sacrament because Our Lord is truly present hidden beneath the thin veil of bread. During Adoration the Blessed Sacrament is removed from the tabernacle and placed in the monstrance so that we the Faithful may adore our Lord and God 'face to face.'

At Adoration we show our love, veneration and deep respect for Our Lord Jesus Christ. In many ways we echo the words of the Angel at

Fatima when we say with our voices and hearts:
"My God, I believe, I adore, I hope and I love You! I ask pardon of You for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not hope and do not love

Tabor:
The naming of the stand, *tabor*, is a direct reference to Mount Tabor the high mountain that our Lord took Peter, James and John up, the same mountain top upon which Our Lord's Transfiguration occurred, when "his face shone like the sun and his clothes became white as light" (Mt 17:2) and God the Father spoke directly to the Apostles telling them, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him." (Mt 17:5) That message is for us too. We pray at Adoration listening to the Lord who is again elevated on the tabor in a similar way to that in the Gospel.

<u>Tabernacle:</u>
Peter and the other apostles present at the Transfiguration asked if they should set up tents/booths for Jesus, Moses and Elijah who had appeared with the Lord during the Transfiguration. The word for tent/booth in Hebrew is translated as 'tabernacle' and was known especially as a portable dwelling place for God. Hence the Blessed Eucharist or Sacrament is placed within the tabernacle at church.

Pope St. John Paul II in his address on the feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord in 1999 shared:

"Today, the Eucharist which we are preparing to celebrate takes us in spirit to Mount Tabor together with the Apostles Peter, James, and John, to admire in rapture the splendor of the transfigured Lord. In the event of the Transfiguration we contemplate the mysterious encounter between history, which is being built every day, and the blessed inheritance that awaits us in heaven in full union with Christ, the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End.

We, pilgrims on earth, are granted to rejoice in the company of the transfigured Lord when we immerse ourselves in the things of above through prayer and the celebration of the divine mysteries."
