

I invite you to join me in praying for our brothers and sisters throughout our State and in our Diocese who have been and are presently affected by the recent fires. In our diocese alone the CZU, River, Carmel Valley and Dolan fires have already caused profound damage to property, persons and the environment. Hundreds of people have already fled their homes fearful of the unknown. Likewise, several of our parish sites have been evacuated due to the close proximity of the fires. Although it may not be clear to us, it is at times like these that we are called to not lose sight that the Lord is with us even amidst the uncertainty of the moment. You and I are called to come together as the Body of Christ, to pray for each other, even if we cannot physically gather in each other's presence. Let us also earnestly pray for our first responders who place themselves in harm's way to protect all of us.

CATECHISM SY 2020-2021

Only some of our youth and children received Confirmation and 1st Communion last week. There are still youth and children from our parish families waiting to receive their Confirmations and 1st Communions. In light of this and the health risks associated with COVID-19, our parish cannot hold youth or child catechism classes, especially while others wait for 2021 to receive Sacraments. Catechism is on hold for a year.

MASS REMINDERS

- The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation issued on March 12, 2020, is still in effect until further notice.
- Even with the resumption of public liturgies, parishioners who are particularly vulnerable should be urged to remain home (e.g. over the age of sixty, have an existing heart or lung conditions, diabetes, or are otherwise immuno-compromised). Such individuals should not volunteer or be asked to volunteer to fulfill liturgical ministries. Likewise, parishioners who feel sick in any way, those with a fever or cough, and those who live with a person found to be positive for COVID-19, should be urged to refrain from public gatherings, including liturgical celebrations, until a doctor determines it is safe for them to do so.
- Even with the return to Mass, we know that many of our parishioners will continue to join with us virtually through continued Mass on our parish YouTube Channel, parish website, and Facebook.
