## MASS REMINDERS

- 1) The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation issued on March 12, 2020, is still in effect until further notice.
- 2) Even with the resumption of public liturgies, parishioners who are particularly vulnerable should be urged to remain home (e.g. over the age of sixty, have an existing heart or lung conditions, diabetes, or are otherwise immuno-compromised). Such individuals should not volunteer or be asked to volunteer to fulfill liturgical ministries. Likewise, parishioners who feel sick in any way, those with a fever or cough, and those who live with a person found to be positive for COVID-19, should be urged to refrain from public gatherings, including liturgical celebrations, until a doctor determines it is safe for them to do so.
- 3) Even with the return to Mass, we know that many of our parishioners will continue to join with us virtually through continued Mass on our parish YouTube Channel, parish website, and Facebook.

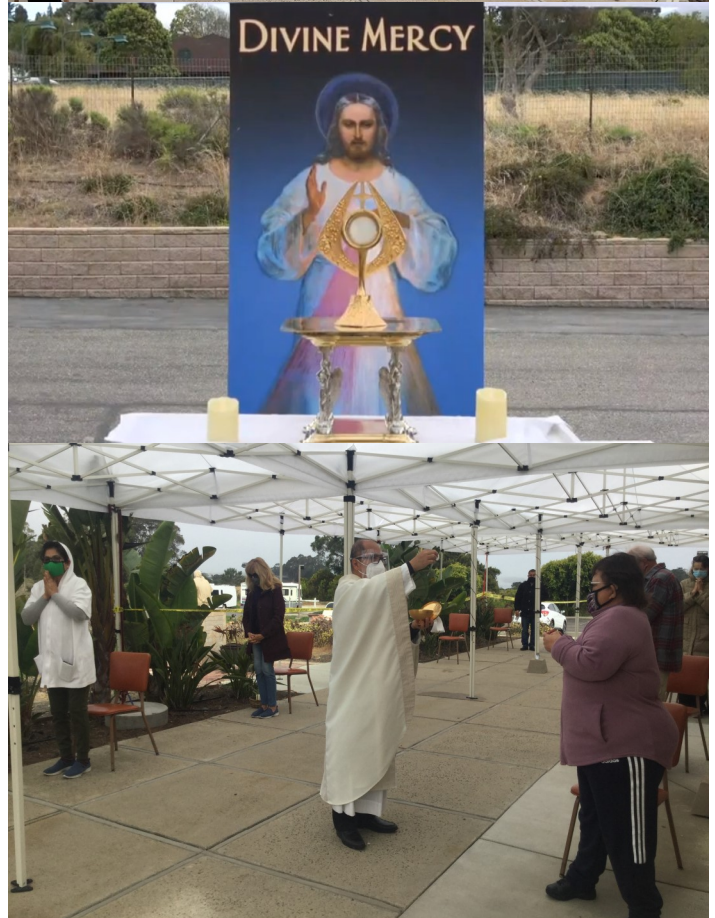

Much appreciation to our donor **Mexican** family for working with Fr. Joey for the gift of the new monstrance for our parish. (Their photo does not appear here because they wanted to remain anonymous.)

This monstrance made its first appearance at the Spanish Adoration this week in tribute to the family's heritage.

What is a monstrance?

A monstrance (from the Latin *monstrancia*, from *monstrare*) also called an ostensorium (from two Latin *ostendere*) both mean 'to show.' Who is being shown? As St. Peter says, "The Messiah, the Son of the Living God," Our Lord Jesus Christ. (Mt 16:16)

In the early church processions would take place and the Eucharist would be carried in a closed golden ciborium to honor our Lord and Savior. During the Middle Ages the vessel carrying our Lord changed and a glass added so that the Faithful could see the Lord veiled within the bread during the processions and could better venerate Him. The monstrance is usually made of gold or silver and decorated as befits a king because Our Lord is King of Kings, Lord of the Universe.

Today the monstrance or ostensorium is used at Eucharistic Adoration and still for processions so that the Faithful may love and adore our Lord within the Holy Body and Blood of Christ.

Again, let us keep in our prayers our donor family for their very generous gift of humble praise and thanksgiving to Our Lord and gift to our community. May God bless them.





## SUN AUG 9TH—75TH ANNIVERSARY OF HIROSHIMA AND NAGASAKI

This week we marked the solemn 75th anniversary of the use of nuclear weapons on the cities of Hiroshima and Nagasaki in Japan. Nuclear weapons still pose a threat to our world. We are called to pray for peace and take action in solidarity with our brothers and sisters globally. The Catholic Church in Japan observes "Ten Days of Prayer for Peace" each year at this time.
