

"Catechesis is a distinct and special ministry in the Church. As the Catechism of the Catholic Church makes clear, "Catechesis is intimately bound up with the whole of the Church's life . . . her inner growth and correspondence with God's plan depend essentially on catechesis" (no. 7). This ministry of teaching in the name of the Church has a profound dignity, which is why catechists are formally commissioned by the Church. It is only fitting that we set aside a day to highlight this ministry and invite the entire church community to think about our responsibility to share our faith with others."

"Parents are truly the primary catechists of their children. They prepare the soil and plant the first seeds of faith. On Catechetical Sunday, we not only highlight the work of catechists in parishes and schools, but we also commend parents and guardians and encourage them to take seriously their role of making their Catholic households a place where this passed on to the next generation. This is why the rite of blessing of catechists used on Catechetical Sunday includes an optional blessing of parents and guardians."

### **VANDALISM AT S.E.A.S.**

Somebody broke the window glass near the sacristy and electric outlet cover near the kitchen door the night of September 5th. Javier discovered it in the morning on Sept 6th as he prepared for Mass. He promptly reported it to the Sheriff Office, who dispatched deputies that came out to investigate. It appeared that whoever did this did not have the intention to steal things inside the church building but to tap into our electrical outlets.

More vandalism was discovered on the morning of September 16th at the prayer garden for Our Lady just outside the parish office. It happened on the night of Sept 15th. Lattice work behind the bench has pieces missing and has been pulled away from its frame in some areas.





### **MASS REMINDERS**

- The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation issued on March 12, 2020, is still in effect until further notice.
- Even with the resumption of public liturgies, parishioners who are particularly vulnerable should be urged to remain home (e.g. over the age of sixty, have an existing heart or lung conditions, diabetes, or are otherwise immuno-compromised). Such individuals should not volunteer or be asked to volunteer to fulfill liturgical ministries. Likewise, parishioners who feel sick in any way, those with a fever or cough, and those who live with a person found to be positive for COVID-19, should be urged to refrain from public gatherings, including liturgical celebrations, until a doctor determines it is safe for them to do so them to do so.
