

### **NEW CA REOPENING PLAN**

With the new re-opening plans released by Gov. Newsome on Aug. 31st nothing changes for the Catholic Church within our Diocese of Monterey as we still have many restrictions.

We will continue to have outdoor Masses and celebrate the sacraments as we have these last 12 weeks. Thank you for registering for Mass!

#### **MASS REMINDERS**

- The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation issued on March 12, 2020, is still in effect until further notice.
- 2) Even with the resumption of public liturgies, parishioners who are particularly vulnerable should be urged to remain home (e.g. over the age of sixty, have an existing heart or lung conditions, diabetes, or are otherwise immuno-compromised). Such individuals should not volunteer or be asked to volunteer to fulfill liturgical ministries. Likewise, parishioners who feel sick in any way, those with a fever or cough, and those who live with a person found to be positive for COVID-19, should be urged to refrain from public gatherings, including liturgical celebrations, until a doctor determines it is safe for them to do so.
- Even with the return to Mass, we know that many of our parishioners will continue to join with us virtually through continued Mass on our parish YouTube Channel, parish website, and Facebook.
