#### S.E.A.S. BUILDING FUND

Were you surprised by the 2nd Collection on Jan 3rd for the S.E.A.S. Building Repair Fund? Well, we have found that our buildings need a little TLC (tender loving care). This fund is being used specifically for the repair and up-keep of the buildings. It will be a quarterly 2nd collection during the year and will be posted in the bulletin. For those of you who use envelopes, you have the envelopes for the Building Repair Fund inside your package of them. For others, feel free to use any envelope and write that it is for this fund. So, what is special about this fund? What sets it apart from the others we have?

You may remember the pipe leading to the downspout on the roof got plugged up with feathers, crab skeletons & peanut shells from the birds that like to visit. The water damaged caused by that to the sacristy ceiling and the cracks in the roof asphalt roof will be paid by this fund. What else? There are always little things to be repaired: door stops that no longer work, loose doorknobs, paint for spot treating walls and to mark the rises in the sidewalks, fire extinguisher & emergency sign servicing, electricians, etc. Then there are the big things like the broken water main that needs repair.

We are grateful for the donations given for the Building Fund in our 2nd collection. The money collected will be put to good use for the repair of the building. Thank you so much! However, we could use some extra funding for the broken water main. It has been a couple weeks that the church has been without water. It does not affect the water for the rectory. During the COVID shutdown, water has been/is used for emergency bathroom use, water for the sacristy (instead of using bottled water) and kitchen (where food for People's Kitchen is prepared), cleaning, and the ability to have use of water for work projects around our church campus.







#### ST. BLAISE & ASH WEDNESDAY

#### Blessing of Throats on the memorial of St. Blaise (February 3)

Note that the Book of Blessings contains the following provision for this rite:

1628. If, for pastoral reasons, each individual cannot be blessed in the manner described in no. 1627, for example when great numbers are gathered for the blessing or when the memorial of Saint Blaise occurs on a Sunday, a priest or deacon may give the blessing to all assembled by extending hands, without the crossed candles, over the people while saying the prayer of blessing. A lay minister says the prayer proper to lay ministers without making the sign of the cross.

The current circumstances would certainly be considered a sufficient pastoral reason to avoid administration of the blessing to individuals in the usual manner, should there be any concern of danger due to the ongoing pandemic.

#### Distribution of Ashes on Ash Wednesday (February 17)

While Ash Wednesday is not a holyday of obligation and while there is no requirement for the clergy and faithful to receive the imposition of ashes, it is rightly observed as a celebration of high importance, and many will surely wish to participate even amid the current difficulties.

During this time of pandemic, the **Holy See** has modified the method of distributing the ashes, as outlined in the following "Note":

#### Prot. N. 17/21 NOTE ON ASH WEDNESDAY Distribution of Ashes in Time of Pandemic

The Priest says the prayer for blessing the ashes. He sprinkles the ashes with holy water, without saying anything. Then he addresses all those present and only once says the formula as it appears in the Roman Missal, applying it to all in general: "Repent, and believe in the Gospel", or "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return".

The Priest then cleanses his hands, puts on a face mask and distributes the ashes to those who come to him or, if appropriate, he goes to those who are standing in their places. The Priest takes the ashes and sprinkles them on the head of each one without saying anything.

From the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments, 12 January 2021.

#### MASS REMINDERS

- The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation issued on March 12, 2020, is still in effect until further notice.
- 2) Even with the resumption of public liturgies, parishioners who are particularly vulnerable should be urged to remain home (e.g. over the age of sixty, have an existing heart or lung conditions, diabetes, or are otherwise immuno-compromised). Such individuals should not volunteer or be asked to volunteer to fulfill liturgical ministries. Likewise, parishioners who feel sick in any way, those with a fever or cough, and those who live with a person found to be positive for COVID-19, should be urged to refrain from public gatherings, including liturgical celebrations, until a doctor determines it is safe for them to do so.
- Even with the return to Mass, we know that many of our parishioners will continue to join with us virtually through continued Mass on our parish website, and Facebook, and YouTube channel.
