MASS REMINDERS

- 1) The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation issued on March 12, 2020, is still in effect until further notice. Please expect that that the dispensation may end this summer.
- 2) Parishioners who feel sick in any way, those with a fever or cough, and those who live with a person found to be positive for COVID-19, should be urged to refrain from public gatherings, including liturgical celebrations, until a doctor determines it is safe for them to do so.

ADORATION CHAPEL Q & A SERIES #25

Q: Is there a difference between going to Adoration and praying before the tabernacle?

A: The Second Vatican Council, notably the Sacred Congregation of Rites on May 25, 1967 published *Eucharisticum Mysterium* – Instruction on Eucharistic Worship, touches on this subject and does not give an essential difference; one is not better than the other:

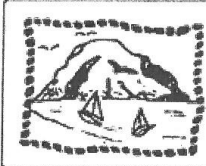
"The exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, for which either a monstrance or a ciborium may be used, stimulates the faithful to an awareness of the marvelous presence of Christ and is an invitation to spiritual communion with him. It is therefore an excellent encouragement to offer him that worship in spirit and truth which is his due" (Eucharisticum Mysterium, No. 60)
