## **ADORATION CHAPEL Q & A SERIES #26**

Q: My pastor is suggesting that I spend some time at Adoration. It this normal?

**A:** Yes. It is appropriate for a pastor or any priest to encourage public and private devotion of the Blessed Eucharist. Vatican II's The Constitution of the Sacred Liturgy includes *Eucharistae Sacramentum* aka *On Holy Communion and the Worship of the Eucharistic Mystery Outside of Mass*, no 79-80 states:

"Since the eucharistic sacrifice is the source and summit of the whole Christian life, devotion, both public and private, to the blessed Sacrament according to the norms laid down by legitimate authority is strongly recommended...The faithful should, therefore, be zealous in keeping with their conditions in life, in devotion to the blessed Sacrament. Pastors should encourage them in this by their example and their teaching."
