O Mary, you shine continuously on our journey as a sign of salvation and hope.


We entrust ourselves to you, Health of the Sick. At the foot of the Cross you participated in Jesus' pain with steadfast faith.

MASS REMINDERS

- The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation issued on March 12, 2020, is still in effect until further notice. Please expect that that the dispensation may end this summer.

ADORATION CHAPEL Q & A SERIES #30 Q: What is the connection between Adoration and the Mass?

A: One of her love songs, Belinda Carlisle belted out, "Heaven is a place on Earth. They say in Heaven, love comes first..." She was right. At Mass the heavenly or divine is very real and present to us: we are in the presence of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe.

Teresa Nguyen, author of Why Mass is Better than Adoration available at the Catholic website, lifeteen.com reminds us of the reality of being one foot in heaven, one foot on the earth when at Mass. Nguyen wrote quoting Catholic Speaker, Mark Hart: "Make no mistake: The Mass is not about God 'reaching down' it earth as much as it is about being swept up into Heaven." Nguyen wrote, "The reason so many of us love Adoration is because we get to take the time to process and experience the mystery of Jesus' real presence. However, the love for the Eucharist that we experience in Adoration should point us to the Mass."
