ADORATION CHAPEL UPDATE

Interior paint preparations took place. Plastic coverings on the windows were replaced; holes from nails and cracks between boards had painter putty applied. Floors were covered with paper. ADORATION CHAPEL Q & A SERIES #28

Q: Why do we pray quietly at Adoration? Is it better to pray quietly?

A: In his pastoral letter on adoration of the Most Holy Eucharist from Holy Thursday, 2017, Bishop James Conley, reminds us that true Christian **silence** becomes sacred silence as it becomes silence of communion. He writes:

"God's first language," said St. John of the Cross, "is silence." In the silence of Eucharistic adoration, we learn true humility. As we kneel before our Creator-God, we are confronted with the power and the mystery of God's love. And it is from this silence and humility that we experience a deep communion and friendship with God.

Cardinal Robert Sarah says that "silence is an attitude of the soul," and that when we adore the Lord in silence, his presence fills our hearts, our minds, and our imaginations. (seeLove Made Visible (lincolndiocese.org)
