## MASS INTENTIONS

Thank you to the many of you who have started using our parish website for Mass Intentions.

To make a Mass Intention:

1. Visit our parish website from either a cell phone, tablet, or computer. Go to [seasparishlo.org](http://seasparishlo.org)
2. Scroll down to the button marked, 'Mass Intention Request' and click on it.
3. In the new window, click on the button that says, 'Request a Mass Intention.'
4. A list of dates and Mass times will appear, according to month. Simply click on the Mass time for the day that you would like to have the Mass said on.
5. Under 'Mass Intention', write the name of the person that you would like to have the Mass said for.
6. Next, select the category, then indicate who you are and offer your contact information.
7. If the Mass to be offered needs to have a Mass card sent to someone, please give that information in the section indicated.
8. Once you have clicked on the 'Submit' button, you will be prompted to give your donation electronically.

Please note: If there is not a request button for a day, it means that the maximum amount of Mass Intentions for that Mass has been reached.

## MASS REMINDERS

- 1) The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation issued on March 12, 2020, is still in effect until further notice. Please expect that that the dispensation may end this summer.
- 2) Parishioners who feel sick in any way, those with a fever or cough, and those who live with a person found to be positive for COVID-19, should be urged to refrain from public gatherings, including liturgical celebrations, until a doctor determines it is safe for them to do so.
- 3) Even with the return to Mass, we know that many of our parishioners will continue to join with us virtually through continued Mass on our parish website, and Facebook, and YouTube channel.
- 4) Vaccinated and unvaccinated persons are required wear properly fitting masks at Mass and other gatherings at the church.
- 5) S.E.A.S. parish bulletin will continue to be emailed to parishioners whose email we have. (To add your name, send an email to the office email.) The Bulletin is also published on our website and MyParishApp.

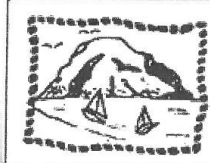
