NEW MASS REGISTRATION SYSTEM

You will be asked for your name, email/cell ph. for registration confirmations, and the number of people who will attend in your group. You will receive an instant confirmation. We have been using this system for Wed Feb 10th until now without issue.

ASH WEDNESDAY

Distribution of Ashes on Ash Wednesday (February 17)

While Ash Wednesday is not a holyday of obligation and while there is no requirement for the clergy and faithful to receive the imposition of ashes, it is rightly observed as a celebration of high importance, and many will surely wish to participate even amid the current difficulties.

During this time of pandemic, the **Holy See** has modified the method of distributing the ashes, as outlined in the following "Note":

Prot. N. 17/21 NOTE ON ASH WEDNESDAY Distribution of Ashes in Time of Pandemi

The Priest says the prayer for blessing the ashes. He sprinkles the ashes with holy water, without saying anything. Then he addresses all those present and only once says the formula as it appears in the Roman Missal, applying it to all in general: "Repent, and believe in the Gospel", or "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return".

The Priest then cleanses his hands, puts on a face mask and distributes the ashes to those who come to him or, if appropriate, he goes to those who are standing in their places. The Priest takes the ashes and sprinkles them on the head of each one without saying anything.

MASS REMINDERS

- 1) The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation issued on March 12, 2020, is still in effect until further notice.
- 2) Even with the resumption of public liturgies, parishioners who are particularly vulnerable should be urged to remain home (e.g. over the age of sixty, have an existing heart or lung conditions, diabetes, or are otherwise immuno-compromised). Such individuals should not volunteer or be asked to volunteer to fulfill liturgical ministries. Likewise, parishioners who feel sick in any way, those with a fever or cough, and those who live with a person found to be positive for COVID-19, should be urged to refrain from public gatherings, including liturgical celebrations, until a doctor determines it is safe for them to do so.
- 3) Even with the return to Mass, we know that many of our parishioners will continue to join with us virtually through continued Mass on our parish website, and Facebook, and YouTube channel.
- 4) To register for weekend in person Mass, please use the "reserve my seat" button on our parish website to register. **You need to register for each Mass and must receive a confirmation message.** Thanks!
- 5) Weekend Liturgy aids and the S.E.A.S. parish bulletin will continue to be emailed to parishioners whose email we have. (To add your name, just send an email to the office email.) They are also available on the parish website and MyParishApp.

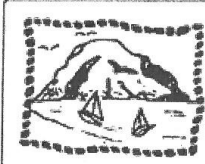
