# LENT

Reminder: Lenten Abstinence (Fridays) and Lenten Fast (on Ash Wed. & Good Friday)

<u>Abstinence</u>: (14yrs & older) from Meat (chicken, beef, pork)

Fasting: (18-59yrs old) 1 regular meal, 2 snacks that together do not equal 1 full meal

#### Elders & sick are exempt.





# MASS REMINDERS

- 1) The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation issued on March 12, 2020, is still in effect until further notice.
- 2) Even with the resumption of public liturgies, parishioners who are particularly vulnerable should be urged to remain home (e.g. over the age of sixty, have an existing heart or lung conditions, diabetes, or are otherwise immuno-compromised). Such individuals should not volunteer or be asked to volunteer to fulfill liturgical ministries.

Likewise, <u>parishioners who feel sick in any way, those</u> with a fever or cough, and those who live with a person found to be positive for COVID-19, should be urged to refrain from public gatherings, including liturgical celebrations, until a doctor determines it is safe for them to do so.

- Even with the return to Mass, we know that many of our parishioners will continue to join with us virtually through continued Mass on our parish website, and Facebook, and YouTube channel.
- 4) To register for weekend in person Mass, please use the "reserve my seat' button on our parish website to register. You <u>can</u> do it from a cell phone. You need to register for each Mass and must receive a confirmation message.
