**SUBJECT:** COVID-19 Vaccine

**DATE:** March 12, 2021

**The Diocese of Monterey would like to encourage our parishioners to get the COVID-19 Vaccination.**

While Catholic moral teaching can be complex and nuanced, in the analysis of vaccinations during this Pandemic, there is clear guidance.

Catholic theologians, the US Conference of Catholic Bishops, the Congregation of the Doctrine of Faith in Rome, and Pope Francis, have all clearly concluded that to take the vaccine, be it Pfizer, Moderna, or Johnson & Johnson, is clearly a legitimate moral choice in this time of Pandemic with limited vaccine options.

I share with you that I have taken the vaccine, Pope Francis and Pope Emeritus Benedict, and many of the clergy of the Diocese have done so. Unless one's personal doctor recommends otherwise, **I strongly urge everyone to take the vaccine for the protection of human life and well-being of all.**

Si bien la enseñanza moral católica puede ser compleja y matizada, hay una guía clara basada en el análisis de las vacunas para esta pandemia.

Los teólogos Católicos, la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos, la Congregación de la Doctrina de la Fe en Roma y el Papa Francisco, han concluido claramente que el recibir la vacuna, ya sea la de Pfizer, la de Moderna, o la de Johnson & Johnson, es una opción moral claramente legítima en este tiempo de pandemia, con opciones limitadas de vacunas.

3 Free Tuesday zoom sessions: March 9, 16, and 23

Join us as we examine restorative justice practices through the lens of Fratelli Tutti. **FRATELLI TUTTI**, Pope Francis' recent encyclical that focuses on the gospel call to a love that transcends the barriers of geography, culture and distance and declares that we are all brothers and sisters. Speakers include three staff members of Restorative Partners: Sister Theresa Harpin, Founder and Executive Director, Sister Milda Avila, Jail Chaplain and Vivien Devaney-Frice, Director of In-Custody and Reentry Programs. Other guest speakers will include those with lived experience with our mission.

## MASS REMINDERS

- 1) The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation issued on March 12, 2020, is still in effect until further notice.
- 2) Even with the resumption of public liturgies, parishioners who are particularly vulnerable should be urged to remain home (e.g. over the age of sixty, have an existing heart or lung conditions, diabetes, or are otherwise immuno-compromised). Such individuals should not volunteer or be asked to volunteer to fulfill liturgical ministries.

Likewise, parishioners who feel sick in any way, those with a fever or cough, and those who live with a person found to be positive for COVID-19, should be urged to refrain from public gatherings, including liturgical celebrations, until a doctor determines it is safe for them to do so.

- 3) Even with the return to Mass, we know that many of our parishioners will continue to join with us virtually through continued Mass on our parish website, and Facebook, and YouTube channel.
- 4) To register for weekend in person Mass, please use the "reserve my seat" button on our parish website to register. You can do it from a cell phone. **You need to register for each Mass and must receive a confirmation message.**

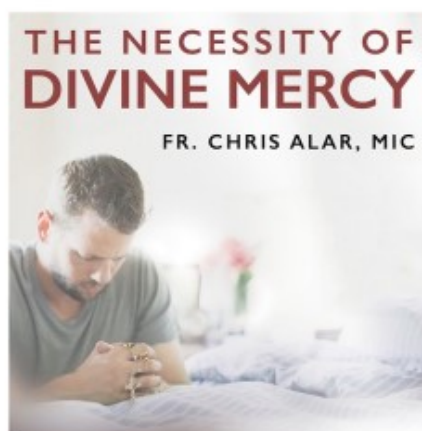

This weekend you may not notice the work that was done. We wish to share with you some images of it.



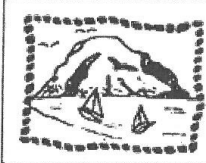
