# ADORATION CHAPEL Q & A SERIES #5

## Q: Did Pope St. John Paul II start 24/7 Adoration?

**A:** No. There are many online sources such as NewAdvent.org, kolbeshrine.org, USCatholic.org, etc. that report about perpetual Adoration being held as far back as 1594 by the Society of Picpus, 1641 by Baron de Renty and the Ladies' Society at St. Paul's Church in Paris, an 1648 at St. Sulpice perpetual adoration of the Blessed Sacrament was used as reparation of thieves for their abominations toward the Blessed Eucharist. 'Perpetual Adoration' has been around for awhile.

It was Pope St. John Paul II that instituted 'The Year of the Eucharist' as the name for the liturgical year 2005 calling the Eucharist the "Light and Life of the New Millenia" in his address or address on October 17, 2004. In his homily he encouraged a renewed awareness of "the Eucharist as the source and manifestation of communion." He encouraged the Faithful to adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, of Christ truly present to us. This prompted a renewal worldwide of love and devotion to the Blessed Eucharist.

"The Eucharist is light! In the Word of God constantly proclaimed, in the bread and wine that have become the Body and Blood of Christ, it is precisely he, the risen Lord, who opens minds and hearts and makes us recognize him, as he made the two disciples at Emmaus recognize him, in the "breaking of the bread" (cf. Lk 24: 35). In this convivial gesture we relive the sacrifice of the Cross, we experience God's infinite love, we feel called to spread Christ's light among the men and women of our time."

- 1) The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation issued on March 12, 2020, is still in effect until further notice.
- 2) Even with the resumption of public liturgies, parishioners who are particularly vulnerable should be urged to remain home (e.g. over the age of sixty, have an existing heart or lung conditions, diabetes, or are otherwise immuno-compromised).
