MASS REMINDERS

- The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation issued on March 12, 2020, is still in effect until further notice.
- Even with the resumption of public liturgies, parishioners who are particularly vulnerable should be urged to remain home (e.g. over the age of sixty, have an existing heart or lung conditions, diabetes, or are otherwise immuno-compromised). Such individuals should not volunteer or be asked to volunteer to fulfill liturgical ministries.

Likewise, parishioners who feel sick in any way, those with a fever or cough, and those who live with a person found to be positive for COVID-19, should be urged to refrain from public gatherings, including liturgical celebrations, until a doctor determines it is safe for them to do so.

- 3) Even with the return to Mass, we know that many of our parishioners will continue to join with us virtually through continued Mass on our parish website, and Facebook, and YouTube channel.

ADORATION CHAPEL Q & A SERIES #6

Q: If Mass is the source and summit of Christian life, why have Eucharistic Adoration?

A. Although the Holy Mass should be the 'source and summit' of our lives (CCC 1324) we also need to nourish our soul outside of Mass. Worship of the Most Holy Eucharist is one way. In Ecclesia de Eucharistia (#10, 25), Pope St. John Paul II wrote regarding Eucharistic Adoration outside of Mass, "an important daily practice that becomes an inexhaustible source of holiness"...and an "inestimable value for the life of the Church...it is the responsibility of Pastors to encourage, also by their personal witness, the practice of Eucharistic Adoration, and exposition of the Blessed Sacrament in particular, as well as prayer of Adoration before Christ present under the Eucharistic species."


