

For those giving envelopes at the beginning of Mass, please know that there is already a Mass intention for that day. Your loved one will be mentioned in the petitions, and a Mass will be given specifically for them later.

ADORATION CHAPEL Q & A SERIES #3

Q: I've never heard of an Adoration Chapel. How long have they been around?

A: According to Fr. John Hardon, SJ (See EWTN website) from Apostolic times to the Middle Ages belief in the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist grew based upon the teachings of the Evangelists and St. Paul.

US Catholic's Feb 21, 2011 article by Victoria Tufano adoration of the Blessed Eucharist is an ancient practice due to Christ being truly present in the Eucharist. Adoration as we know it has evolved throughout the centuries. Tufano writes.

"In the earliest years of Christianity, consecrated bread would be brought home from the celebration of the Eucharist to be given to those not able to be present at the liturgy because of illness. It was also to be consumed by the faithful during the week to keep them connected to the Eucharist and the community they celebrated with."

Both Hardon and Tufano discuss the early Monastics and hermits as reserving the Blessed Eucharist and keeping the Host with them during the week; worshiping Christ in the Eucharist; sometimes carrying to and sharing it with other communities; but also reserving the Eucharist for the sick. These practices evolved over the centuries.

In 1226 to celebrate his victory over the Albigensians, King Louis VIII of France began the first Adoration Chapel open to the laity in thanksgiving to God. With the guidance of the Holy Spirit, Adoration of the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist has become what it is today.

MASS REMINDERS

- 1) The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation issued on March 12, 2020, is still in effect until further notice.
- 2) Even with the resumption of public liturgies, parishioners who are particularly vulnerable should be urged to remain home (e.g. over the age of sixty, have an existing heart or lung conditions, diabetes, or are otherwise immuno-compromised). Such individuals should not volunteer or be asked to volunteer to fulfill liturgical ministries.
 - Likewise, <u>parishioners</u> who feel sick in any way, those with a fever or cough, and those who live with a person found to be positive for COVID-19, should be urged to refrain from public gatherings, including liturgical celebrations, until a doctor determines it is safe for them to do so.
- Even with the return to Mass, we know that many of our parishioners will continue to join with us virtually through continued Mass on our parish website, and Facebook, and YouTube channel.
- 4) To register for weekend in person Mass, please use the "reserve my seat' button on our parish website to register. You <u>can</u> do it from a cell phone. You need to register for each Mass and must receive a confirmation message.

Masks, social distancing, and other safety protocols strictly enforced at Mass.


This is CHARITY to those not yet vaccinated at this time.
