

RE: REOPENING / UPDATED GUIDELINES BY MONTEREY DIOCESE

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

God's Love and Peace!

We offer grateful praise to God as California and all parishes of our Diocese open to almost prepandemic levels starting June 15, 2021!

Here are the pertinent guidelines issued by our Diocese concerning our *Liturgical and Other Church Services and Parish Events*. I added some items about our unique parish context.

"This reflects the allowed practices from the California Department of Health. Please know that these are likely to continue to evolve.

Bishop Danny strongly recommends that everyone be vaccinated. If people choose not or cannot, they ought to continue to wear face masks at Mass or other events.

We can now return to most pre-pandemic practices with a few exceptions. Please note the following items:

- The dispensation from the Sunday Obligation will remain in place at this time. This is subject to change later this Summer.
- Although the California Department of Public Health has made some changes for vaccinated people, masks are required for unvaccinated people. A sign will be posted, which says, "For fully vaccinated individuals a facemask is not required. For not vaccinated individuals, a facemask is required indoors."
- 3. Singing: Congregational singing will now be allowed, but those who are unvaccinated, must wear a mask or refrain from singing. (The whole S.E.A.S. vaccinated weekend assembly, starting this weekend of June 19 & 20, will be the "choir" and not a selected group of singers. A volunteer cantor may be assigned to help the whole assembly sing. We will still use the Hausser family's recorded music at this time since parish musicians require many days or weeks of rehearsals. The liturgical music ministry would be under the pastor's direct supervision.)
- The Distribution of the Chalice: The Precious Blood will continue to be suspended at this time until further notice. Bishop Danny will re-introduce reception under this species at a later date.
- Distancing: the 6 ft. safe distancing is no longer required for indoor and outdoor services.

- 6. Sign of Peace. The Sign of Peace can be resumed, either as a gesture, if not a traditional handshake.
- 7. Bulletins and songbooks: these may now be used. (Here at S.E.A.S, we will continue to email bulletin soft copies and distribute hard copies to the homebound. To reduce expenses, we discontinue bulk printing of bulletin.) There is no need to sanitize the songbooks or worship aids.
- 8. (S.E.A.S. reverts to the use of one ambo for the proclamation of God's Word and Homily. The commentator's ambo will go back to its original location.)
- Sanitizing: please continue to place hand sanitizer near the entrances. Sanitizing between services is no longer required.
- 10. Baptismal fonts and Holy Water stoups may now be placed back in use.
- At the pastor's discretion, outdoor Masses and other services may continue to be offered in addition to indoor Masses and services.
- 12. Restrictions for gatherings and receptions previously issued are no longer required. (Here at S.E.A.S., we will resume our traditional "Hospitality Meal" immediately after the 12:00 noon Mass of Bishop Danny Garcia, June 27, 2021. We cannot do it after the 9:00 am Mass because of preparations for Bishop Danny's 12:00 noon Mass.)
- It is strongly recommended that Eucharistic Ministers use sanitizing gel prior to the distribution of Communion.
- 14. (Before returning to active duty, all S.E.A.S. adult liturgical ministers and other parish volunteers ministering to children and vulnerable adults must complete VIRTUS, and email the certificate to the parish office. Please ask for help from parish staff Heather and Javier.)
- 15. Bringing Communion to the homebound and the sick may resume by fully vaccinated ministers, with the use of a facemask and sanitizing gel.
- 16. Altar servers may resume their ministry.
- 17. Communion on the tongue may resume. Sanitizing gel should be near to the Eucharistic Ministers in case their hand was to come in contact with the communicant's mouth. "

We welcome these guidelines with grateful hearts to our Almighty God! We open responsibly, safely, and with care for the health and well-being of everybody. We will keep the parish community posted as we gradually resume our pre-pandemic parish activities.



ADORATION CHAPEL Q & A SERIES #8

Q: If I am alone with Jesus during Adoration and the Blessed Eucharist is exposed, can I leave if I'm done with my prayer or if I have another reason like I need to use the restroom?

A: Great question! First, you're right, there is a difference between adoration and exposition. Anyone can adore the Eucharist whether it is exposed in the monstrance (or luna) or not.

Secondly, no, we should not leave the Exposition of the Blessed Eucharist especially if we are alone. The Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments in March 2004 issued <u>Redemptionis Sacramentum</u> which states:

states: "[Paragraph 138.] Still, the Most Holy Sacrament, when exposed, must never be left unattended even for the briefest space of time. It should therefore be arranged that at least some of the faithful always be present at fixed times, even if they take alternating turns."

Therefore many parishes, like ours, will strive to have at least 2 Adorers with the Blessed Eucharist when it is exposed.
