

ADORATION CHAPEL Q & A SERIES #11

Q: Remember when we used to genuflect when we came to and left Mass? Do we genuflect in an Adoration Chapel, or does it not matter anymore either?

A: Prior to 1962 it was common practice in the Catholic Church to genuflect (kneeling down on knee, for God on the right knee, in adoration and reverence) toward the altar when entering or leaving a pew outside of Mass. This is because the tabernacle containing the precious Lord and God, King of Kings within the Blessed Eucharist.

"To me every knee shall bend." (Is 45:23, Rom. 14:11)

*Pope Benedict XVI wrote in (Sacramentum Caritatus, #65), "The act of **kneeling** ... the bodily gesture attains the status of a confession of faith in Christ. Words could not replace such a confession."*


We genuflect and kneel before the presence of God in the Eucharist in adoration and love at the beginning and end of this special time. If unable to genuflect on the right knee, a profound bow may be given as sign of reverence. One may sit with God otherwise in silent prayer.
