


In my video message of February of 2021, I shared with you that the Holy See has made it clear that receiving the COVID-19 vaccine is morally acceptable. Likewise, the Holy See affirmed that all vaccines now available are morally permissible and can be used in good conscience. Pope Francis has highly encouraged the vaccination as an act of safeguarding one's own health as well as that of others – pointing us to the importance of the *common good*, such a key element of Catholic Social Teaching. Indeed, both Pope Francis and Pope Emeritus Benedict have received the vaccine as examples for us. The Bishops of California have also encouraged vaccination for the same reasons listed above.

For these reasons, I will not issue, and I have directed our clergy not to issue, any Letters of Religious exemption because it would contradict the clear objective teaching of the Catholic Church and the Holy See on this matter.

I want to take this opportunity to once more, encourage those who have not done so, and have no medical impediments to avoid it, to get vaccinated. Let us continue to pray that the Lord accompany us during these times of additional risk, help us to make the most responsible decisions in our conscience, and to pray as well, for greater unity in our Church and in society.

ADORATION CHAPEL UPDATE

The polishing of the cement floor of the Adoration Chapel was a multi-step process. Machines using diamond segmented abrasives were used to grind down and smooth the floor. Starting with courser grade grits and moving to the finer grit abrasive the floor became reflective. A sealant was added and buffed. The end result is the ability to see reflections in the floor giving it an airer and brighter feel.

Outside during the early part of the week cement walls were made for the edge of the entry cement area and wood placed for future walkways areas.

ADORATION CHAPEL Q & A SERIES #16 Q: Who is Adoration for? Who can go to Adoration? What happens when things go wrong, like if someone starts to pray out loud, or if someone goes up to touch the monstrance?

A: Great questions! We are going to answer each separately. So, who is Adoration for? God created us. God doesn't need us to believe in or adore Him for Him to exist: "The God who made the world and all that is in it, the Lord of heaven and earth, does not dwell in sanctuaries made by human hands, nor is he served by human hands because he needs anything. Rather it is he who gives to everyone life and breath and everything." (Acts 17:24-25) As Catholics we believe "The desire for God is written in the human heart, because man is created by God and for God; and God never ceases to draw man to himself. Only in God will he find the truth and happiness he never stops searching for." (Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC) #27) This desire for God in accordance with our free will draws us to Him through our belief, our adoration, our hope, and our love for our God. Thus, Adoration, is for <u>us</u>, all persons of every background, drawing us closer in communion to our Lord God through His love.
