## 28th/29th — SPECIAL COLLECTION

Our parish is participating in a voluntary special appeal for the USCCB Bishops Emergency Disaster Fund which will be used to support the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops for pastoral and reconstruction needs of the Church as well as the efforts of Catholic Relief Services and/or Catholic Charities USA, the official relief agencies of the U.S. Catholic Church, as they and their local agencies respond to immediate emergency needs and aid in long-term rebuilding and recovery efforts after disasters.

The most immediate focus of this collection will be to help the disaster relief in Haiti in the aftermath of the earthquake that struck last Saturday causing substantial damage and great loss of life on an island already challenged by social unrest and still rebuilding after a major 2010 earthquake. Tropical Storm Grace landed in Haiti this week adding devastation to an already reeling population. As a result of both disasters many Church properties, along with homes and businesses, have been severely damaged or destroyed. The impact will be long-lasting.

According to the USCCB, Catholic Relief Services are on the ground providing humanitarian relief and will be with the community over its extended recovery. The chairman of the Subcommittee on the Church in Latin America has approved \$10,000 grants to each of the three most impacted dioceses to begin to help them as they look to rebuild the many parishes, rectories, schools, and other Church properties reduced to rubble.

Next weekend's 2nd Collection on August 28th & 29th dollars will go a long way in helping our brothers & sisters, even if it is only a few dollars. Please write "USCCB Collection for Haiti" on your envelope or check memo line. Thanks!

## SB 380

From Fr. Derek Hughes (Respect Life Director, Diocese of Monterey):

Currently there is a bill named SB 380 making its way through the California Legislature which will effectively alter and change radically the law with regard to the practice of assisted suicide here in the State of California.

Under the terms of this bill there will be no review of the current law, a review which was promised back in 2015.

The waiting period of 15 days is reduced to 48 hours and the requirement to see whether the patient is of sound mind is watered down almost to a non requirement.

There is little data pertaining to the existing law and pressure can be put on people to end their lives for financial reasons. The new bill does not require doctors to even ask why a person is requesting end of life medication.

There is a great disparity and a definitive socio-economic divide between end of life care offered to and available to, poorer sections of society.

I urge you to request that your congregation write or call their state political representatives to voice opposition to this SB 380 bill.

1. Send a pre-written letter to your Assembly Member by visiting [www.cacatholic.org/action-alerts](http://www.cacatholic.org/action-alerts)
2. Call your Assembly Member and tell them to vote NO on SB 380
  - To find your representative, go to [findyourrep.legislature.ca.gov](http://findyourrep.legislature.ca.gov) and insert your address. Click on the name of your Assembly Member and find their office number through their website.
3. When you call, simply say:  
"Hi, My name is \_\_\_\_\_ and I live in zipcode \_\_\_\_\_. I am calling to ask Assembly Member \_\_\_\_\_ to protect patient's rights and vote NO on SB 380."

### ADORATION CHAPEL Q & A SERIES #17

**Q: Who is Adoration for? Who can go to Adoration? What happens when things go wrong, like if someone starts to pray out loud, or if someone goes up to touch the monstrance?**

**A:** (part 2) Everyone can go to Adoration. Our benefactress of the Adoration Chapel, Grace Tevis, used to tell the story of how her mother would take her and her brother during the middle of running errands to the church for a few minutes to say hello to Jesus. They would walk a block out of their way to go kneel before the Blessed Eucharist resting within the tabernacle to say a prayer. This a form of adoration. It is a great example of how God calls us out of our daily lives to put him at the center of our life. It also shows us that adoring Christ Our Lord is not just for adults, but that children are called to it too.

Catholic Answers at Catholic.com also tackles the question of those of other Christian faiths attending Adoration:

**Q: Can a Protestant go to Adoration?**

**A:** Yes, a Protestant could go to Adoration. Anyone could technically come in and pray. However, the bigger question would be: If someone is attending Catholic Adoration, why isn't he Catholic?


