SB 380

From Fr. Derek Hughes (Respect Life Director, Diocese of Monterey):

Currently there is a bill named SB 380 making its way through the California Legislature which will effectively alter and change radically the law with regard to the practice of assisted suicide here in the State of California.

Under the terms of this bill there will be no review of the current law, a review which was promised back in 2015.

The waiting period of 15 days is reduced to 48 hours and the requirement to see whether the patient is of sound mind is watered down almost to a non requirement.

There is little data pertaining to the existing law and pressure can be put on people to end their lives for financial reasons. The new bill does not require doctors to even ask why a person is requesting end of life medication.

They is a great disparity and a definitive socio-economic divide between end of life care offered to and available to, poorer sections of society.

I urge you to request that your congregation write or call their state political representatives to voice opposition to this SB 380 bill.

ADORATION CHAPEL Q & A SERIES #18 Q: Who is Adoration for? Who can go to Adoration? What happens when things go wrong, like if someone starts to pray out loud, or if someone goes up to touch the monstrance?

A: (part 3) Hopefully adults would not model the kind of behavior put forth in this question. If they do, you may 1) remind them gently that the sacred space, especially in our chapel, is silent and that we don't approach the altar area. If they continue, please move to the entry way to call our parish office to report an issue in the Adoration chapel. Then, return to your seat to continue praying.

Children at Adoration may at times act like children. Parents' actions and directions can lead them to appropriate behavior and postures during Adoration. The follow website has some tips for parents who plan to bring their children including tips like sitting right behind your children so you can whisper quietly into their ear if needed; how to teach them the different prayer postures; and how to help them focus during prayer.
