

ADORATION CHAPEL UPDATE

On Monday of this week the sides for the ramp (to be filled in later) and curb were fashioned out of cement. Painted with a first coat mid-week, the interior was papered for protection from the robotic floor polisher which was used Friday for the 1st round of smoothing and polishing the floor. The forms for the cement area in front of the main door and await cement pouring soon. The dirt in the cement frame for the ramp was levelled and tamped down as was other surrounding dirt in preparation for cement to be poured.
