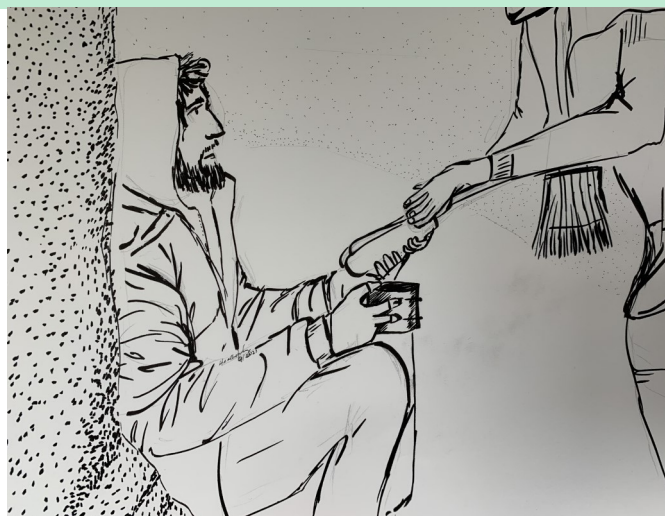

## MASS REMINDERS

- 1) The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation issued on March 12, 2020, is still in effect until further notice. Please expect that that the dispensation may end this summer.
- 2) Parishioners who feel sick in any way, those with a fever or cough, and those who live with a person found to be positive for COVID-19, should be urged to refrain from public gatherings, including liturgical celebrations, until a doctor determines it is safe for them to do so.

- 4) Vaccinated and unvaccinated persons are to wear properly fitting masks at Mass and other gatherings at the church.

## ADORATION CHAPEL Q & A SERIES #20

**Q:** From the photos I've seen our Chapel will have a little entry way, but others like St. Rose's and the Mission don't have this. Is there supposed to be a closed off space between the entrance and where people pray?

**A:** In traditional churches and other buildings, the area sometimes called a lobby is also called a 'narthex.' The area between the narthex and the outer doors may also have another closed off space called a vestibule.

Adoration Chapels do not have to have a narthex, that lobby-type area, that is common to most churches. However, it is advantageous because it reduces noise from opening the entry doors and can regulate temperature.

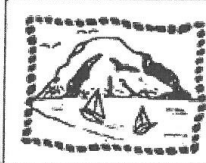
