MASS REMINDERS

- 1) The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation issued on March 12, 2020, is still in effect until further notice. Please expect that that the dispensation may end this summer.
- 2) Parishioners who feel sick in any way, those with a fever or cough, and those who live with a person found to be positive for COVID-19, should be urged to refrain from public gatherings, including liturgical celebrations, until a doctor determines it is safe for them to do so.
- 3) Even with the return to Mass, we know that many of our parishioners will continue to join with us virtually through continued Mass on our parish website, and Facebook, and YouTube channel.
- 4) Vaccinated and unvaccinated persons are to wear properly fitting masks at Mass and other gatherings at the church.

ADORATION CHAPEL Q & A SERIES #22

Q: Why does a bishop have to bless an Adoration Chapel? Why can't the parish priest do it?

A: (Part 2) In our last Q&A we established that the roles of a bishop and priest are different. The blessing of buildings, cemeteries, altars are part of the roll of the bishop. However, a bishop may delegate his authority in special circumstances to the local pastor for specific blessings.

From Canon Law:

Can. 1207 Sacred places are blessed by the ordinary; the blessing of churches, however, is reserved to the diocesan bishop. Either of them, moreover, can delegate another priest for this purpose.

Can. 1208 When the dedication or blessing of a church or the blessing of a cemetery has been completed, a document is to be drawn up, one copy of which is to be kept in the diocesan curia and another in the archive of the church.

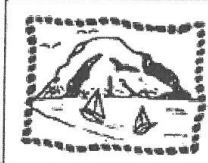
