The Diocesan celebration at Salinas on January 16 of the Santo Niño and the 500th Anniversary of Christianity in the Philippines is **CANCELED** until further notice because of the COVID surge.

22 JAN—DIOCESAN RESPECT LIFE MASS

The Diocesan Respect Life Mass on January 22nd is **CANCELED** due to the COVID surge.

As a people of life, we, the Church believe that life sacred from conception to natural death.

On January 22, 1973, the Supreme Court legalized abortion throughout the United States in its companion decisions Roe v. Wade and Doe v. Bolton.

The Catholic bishops of the United States have designated January 22 as a particular day of prayer and penance, called the "Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children." The General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM), no. 373, directs: In all the Dioceses of the United States of America, January 22 (or January 23, when January 22 falls on a Sunday) shall be observed as a particular day of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion.

This is a head's up about the work to be done.



This is the time to start preparing for the festival. Thank you to those who have already started. You are amazing!

- 1) FOOD HANDLERS: ServSafe.com (approx. \$7) is a Food Hander program that has both CA Food Handler Card (FHC) with ANSI recognized certification. If you plan to work with food prep/serving/temp testing, you will need a food handler card. Already have one? Great! Just drop a copy into the white lock box at Mass or into our parish mailbox. If needed, our parish can reimburse for this, please notify the office.
- 2) <u>SAFE ENVIRONMENT</u>: All parish volunteers need to go through VIRTUS as per the Diocese Safe Environment guidelines. It is online at <u>virtusonline.org</u> Many thanks to those who have already done it!

COVID SURGE MASS REMINDERS

- The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation issued on March 12, 2020, is still in effect until further notice. Please expect that that the dispensation may end this summer.

ADORATION CHAPEL Q & A SERIES #40

Q: Is there really a point to Adoration? Isn't Mass enough? I have to much going on in my life!

R. Many of us are really busy. The real question is, where do we put God in our lives, at the center, or off to the side? Do we make those 'busy' things like social media, tv, gossiping, making extra cash, etc., the center of our life and thus 'mini' gods or false gods?

The Catechism of the Catholic Church states: "Adoration is the first act of the virtue of religion. To adore God is to acknowledge him as God, as the Creator and Savior, Lord and Master of all that exists..."You shall worship the Lord your God, and him only shall you serve," says Jesus, citing Deuteronomy... The worship of God sets man free from turning in on himself, from slavery of sin and idolatry of the world." (CCC 2096-2097)
