RE: SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY COVID-19 SURGE

Dearest Parishioners and Friends,

Happy 2022! We will learn how to live with this COVID-19. As you attend the Sacred Liturgies here at St. Elizabeth's, your well-being and safety are our concern. Here are my reminders as the surge affects our county:

1. BE UPDATED & WELL INFORMED FROM THE CORRECT SOURCES

The Health Agency and Public Health departments of the San Luis Obispo County are doing a great job updating us with the local health situation. Please make it a habit to check their website and news releases regularly. Links are on our parish website.

2. BE AWARE OF YOUR HEALTH ISSUES & LIMITATIONS

You know best your health issues and the probability of getting infected. Wisely decide whether to attend or not our in-person public indoor worship. Please wear winter clothes inside the cold church building.

3. FOLLOW HEALTH PROTOCOLS

Please stay home if you have symptoms or think you have been in close contact with somebody infected. We strictly require: (a) snuggly fit face mask that completely covers the nose and mouth; (b) use hand sanitizers; (c) use church restrooms at your own risk; please wipe all surfaces you touch with provided Lysol wipes; (d) waving, fist and elbow bumps are safer greeting gestures; (e) sit closely with your household members, observing safe distance from acquaintances.

4. SACRAMENTS CONTINUE

The live stream of all our Sacred Liturgies continues. Dispensation is still in effect. Reception of Holy Communion after virtual attendance of Holy Mass must be requested by contacting Heather a day before. This is very important so that the priest or extraordinary minister of the Holy Eucharist can prepare for your arrival. Tuesday Confession is by appointment. Please request the Last Rites whenever possible while the sick is still conscious.

5. SOME ACTIVITIES MAY BE DISCONTINUED. WE'LL KEEP YOU POSTED.

6. CONTACT PARISH OFFICE BEFORE IN-PERSON WINDOW SERVICE

Don't hesitate to contact us by email, call, or text. For convenience, please use our parish website for Mass intentions requests.

RE: ADORATION CHAPEL UPDATE

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Christmas 2021 Blessings to all!

I apologize that our dream to open our Adoration Chapel this Christmas did not happen. With an interesting turnout of events, I realized that it was not God's Will to open our chapel this Christmas Season. Here's my chronological report:

Jul. 30, 2021	I ordered a quote from the church furniture store for 30 chairs with kneelers (Bishop Garcia & I preferred chairs for flexible seating).			
Aug. 2, 2021	Church furniture store gave me a proposal order document.			
	I submitted the same document to Monterey Diocese official for approval.			
	The official requested readable fine prints of the contract.			
Aug. 3, 2021	Church furniture store submitted a blank contract with fine prints that can be zoomed in. I advised them that I would submit it to Monterey Diocese. We wait.			
	I submitted the said document to Monterey Diocese official.			
	We did not get a response from Monterey Diocese.			
	Spirit tells me to wait. Construction supplies are not arriving on time, etc. Homeless issues. Adoration Chapel construction slowed down. Rushing the chair order is pointless.			
Three months				
Nov. 29, 2021	I revived communication with Monterey Diocese since the building structure had been completed. I reminded the diocesan official about the documents I submitted.			
Nov. 30, 2021	Monterey Diocese: church furniture store does not have the license to install church chairs. Chairs won't need to be bolted unless the fire inspector says otherwise.			
	SEAS Parish Office contacted the fire inspector and waited for his in-person visit.			
Dec. 3, 2021	My surgery day.			
Dec. 8, 2021	The fire inspector was on site today and talked with SEAS office manager Javier.			
	Inspector's initial words: unbolted chairs are a non-issue as long as empty space distance to exits are strictly observed.			
	I relayed this to the church furniture store. I requested a change date of the chair order proposal to Dec. 8. Church furniture store complied.			
	I reported the fire inspector's initial comment to the Monterey Diocese official and submitted the chair order proposal dated Dec. 8.			
	Monterey Diocese official released modifications to the fine print of contract for approval of church furniture store.			
Dec. 9, 2021	Church furniture store responded to modifications and asked for the next step.			

	Our adoration chapel contractor & San Luis Obispo County advised me to put			
	on hold the purchase of church chairs until further notice. I notified the church			
	furniture store. The store is grateful.			
Dec. 20, 2021	Today is my in-person meeting with our adoration chapel contractor. We			
	discussed the final decision of the fire inspector: we must follow the approved			
	plan, i.e., since the building construction permit was approved (2019) for no			
	fire sprinkler, seating must be fixed (bolted to the floor). Our contractor will			
	install seating since they have a license.			
Dec. 20, 2021	I contacted the church furniture store about the latest developments. I changed			
	my order proposal from chairs to pews. I also asked them to sign modifications			
	to the fine print.			
Dec. 21, 2021	The Church furniture store gave me signed modifications to the fine print of			
	the contract and new pews proposal, dated Dec. 21, 2021.			
Dec. 22, 2021	I submitted all these documents to Monterey Diocese official with the hope of			
	approval on the last office day before Christmas break.			
	No response, probably due to more pressing diocesan concerns.			
	Monterey Diocese opens on January 3, 2022 Monday.			
	We wait for the response this first week of January 2022.			

Now, we face various current issues:

- 1. We wait for the installation of a shatterproof glass door of monstrance niche;
- New pews delivery waiting time of 90-120 days after Monterey Diocese signs new pews contract and submits payment;
- 3. COVID winter surge;
- 4. Availability of Bishop Garcia to bless our chapel after all things have been installed.

We have booked Bishop Garcia for the Confirmation of our teens on the 1st of July 2022. The same occasion can be a realistic schedule for him to bless our new adoration chapel.

If God wills the blessing to happen before July 1st, God will do it for us.

In the meantime, I pray for everybody's safety and good health as we face serious health challenges due to the COVID winter surge here at San Luis Obispo County and the rest of our country.

Please note that the live streaming of our liturgical services continues and the Dispensation for non-in-person attendance of Masses is still in effect.

You are in my thoughts and prayers. Please pray for my and my staff's safety. Take care.


1st /2nd JANUARY— 2nd COLLECTION BUILDING REPAIR FUND





MASS INTENTIONS

Thank you to the many of you who have started using our parish website for Mass Intentions.

To make a Mass Intention:

- 1. Visit our parish website from either a cell phone, tablet, or computer. Go to **seasparishlo.org**
- 2. Scroll down to the button marked, 'Mass Intention Request' and click on it.
- 3. In the new window, click on the button that says, 'Request a Mass Intention.'
- 4. A list of dates and Mass times will appear, according to month. Simply click on the Mass time for the day that you would like to have the Mass said on.
- 5. Under 'Mass Intention', write the name of the person that you would like to have the Mass said for.
- 6. Next, select the category, then indicate who you are and offer your contact information.
- If the Mass to be offered needs to have a Mass card sent to someone, please give that information in the section indicated.
- 8. Once you have clicked on the 'Submit' button, you will be prompted to give your donation electronically.

Please note: If there is not a request button for a day, it means that the maximum amount of Mass Intentions for that Mass has been reached.

Pews are in the works, awaiting diocesan approval on the contracts.

MASS REMINDERS

- The dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation issued on March 12, 2020, is still in effect until further notice. Please expect that that the dispensation may end this summer.
- 2) Parishioners who feel sick in any way, those with a fever or cough, and those who live with a person found to be positive for COVID-19, should be urged to refrain from public gatherings, including liturgical celebrations, until a doctor determines it is safe for them to do so.
