

RE: END OF DISPENSATION

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

God's Peace and Love.

Last September 20, Bishop Danny sent to all the faithful of the Diocese of Monterey a letter about the end of the "*Dispensation from the Obligation to celebrate Sunday Eucharist*," effective October 8/9, 2022. He said that "*live-streaming for the celebration of the Sacrament of the Eucharist was never meant to be a replacement for being in person*." He invited all who are not ill to return to Mass in person because all are important to the celebration.

In line with this, effective October 8/9, my staff and I:


1. Terminate the emailing and posting of our liturgy live stream links to our parishioners and friends on our *MyParishApp*, parish *Facebook account*, and parish *Facebook page*;
2. Reduce the Sunday live stream to one (1) Mass only, alternating between Saturday Vigil and Sunday;
3. Reduce the Weekday live stream to one (1) day only, i.e., Wednesday;
4. Post the recorded live stream on our parish website only, where our homebound and ill parishioners can access them.

Our recorded liturgies are intended only for the benefit of our homebound and ill parishioners and friends who obviously cannot join us in person at church.

I'll release another letter concerning the Holy Communion of the "Blood of Christ."

Gathering together again in our Holy Liturgies as one family is a blessing! Thanks be to God! We love having everybody back in church! Welcome back!
