Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

On March 20, 2020, due to the pandemic and our inability to join in our public celebration of the Eucharist in person, I granted a *Dispensation from the Obligation to celebrate Sunday Eucharist*. Beginning the weekend of October 8 /9, 2022, The Twenty-Eighth Sunday of Ordinary Time, the dispensation is lifted.

As is the case with any illness, if you are sick, you do not have to go to Sunday Eucharist. This has always been the teaching of the Church. Live-streaming for the celebration of the Sacrament of Eucharist was never meant to be a replacement for being in person. So, if you have not begun to return to Mass at your local parish, I invite you to return to Mass because you are important to the celebration.

Lastly, I announce that as of October 7, 2022, Memorial of our Lady of the Rosary, the offering of the Chalice to the people of God is to be resumed. *The General Instruction to the Roman Missal* is clear that the fullest expression Communion is when both the Body of Christ and the Precious Blood is offered at every celebration of the Eucharist. Please be assured of my prayers.

Estimados hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

El 20 de marzo del 2020, debido a la pandemia y la imposibilidad de reunirnos presencialmente para nuestras celebraciones públicas de la Eucaristía, otorgué una *Dispensa de la Obligación del participar en la Eucaristía dominical*. A partir del fin de semana del 8 y 9 de octubre del 2022, o sea, a partir del Vigésimo Octavo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario, esa dispensa queda levantada.

Como ocurre con cualquier enfermedad, la persona no tiene que ir a la Eucaristía dominical si está enferma. Esta ha sido siempre la enseñanza de la Iglesia. La transmisión en vivo para la celebración del Sacramento de la Eucaristía nunca tuvo la intención de ser un reemplazo al ir a Misa en persona. Entonces, si no han comenzado a regresar a Misa en su parroquia local, los invito a regresar a Misa porque su presencia es importante para estas celebraciones.

Por último, deseo anunciar que, a partir del 7 de octubre de 2022, Memoria de Nuestra Señora del Rosario, se reanuda el ofrecer el Cáliz al pueblo de Dios. *La Instrucción General del Misal Romano* es clara, indicando que la expresión más plena de la Comunión es cuando tanto el Cuerpo de Cristo como la Preciosa Sangre se ofrecen en cada celebración de la Eucaristía. Tengan la seguridad de mis oraciones.

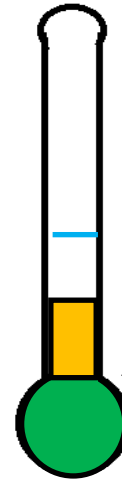

Proposition 1 is a worst-case scenario for abortion in California. It is an expensive and misleading ballot measure that allows unlimited late-term abortions – for any reason, at any time, even moments before birth, paid for by tax dollars.

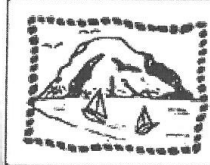
