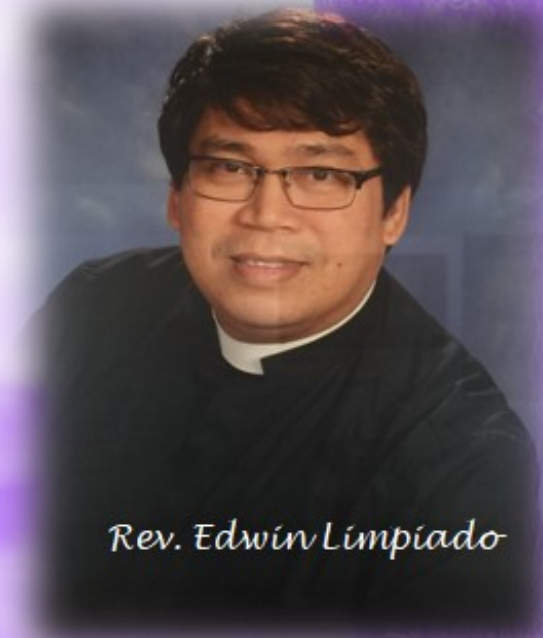

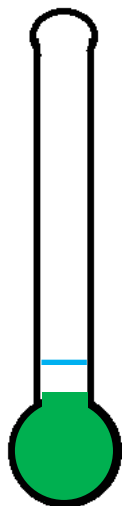

Q: Does everyone have the same experience at Adoration?

A. No. We all have different and unique experiences which color our relationship with Christ. Maybe you are struggling with something while the person next to you is not. Try not to compare your experience with others'. Instead, focus on Christ. Just pray. Ask the Holy Spirit to give you the grace to believe in the Love that the Lord has for you. Thank Him for your life and all that is in it, especially the good by listing them. Ask God for what you need right now. Share what is going on in your life. Ask Him for forgiveness. Thank him for the time that he has spent with you.

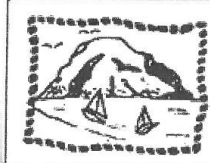
