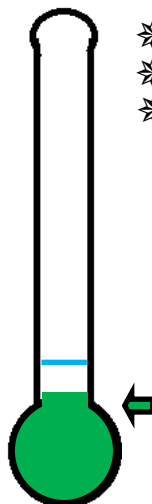

ADORATION CHAPEL Q & A SERIES #50

Q: When can an Adoration Chapel begin to be used for Adoration? Once it is built or once the altar is blessed?

A. The consecration of an Adoration Chapel and altar make them holy and used only for specific purpose according to Church Canon Law, no. 1171: *"Once a religious object is blessed and dedicated for divine worship or veneration, it must be treated with reverence and not be used in either an improper or profane way."*

For this reason then, an Adoration Chapel is not used for Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament nor is an altar for that matter, until it has been consecrated by the Bishop whose faculty it is to do so.

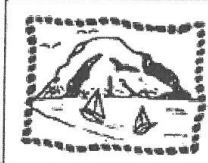
