OPTION 2) Bring a white orchid in bloom to the church on Good Friday (April 15) with the printed name of your loved one attached.


Names of your loved ones will be listed in the Easter bulletin and on our website's Virtual Easter Memorial.

This is an extension of the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament which occurs in every Mass... The Rite concludes with the ordained minister blessing the faithful with the Blessed Sacrament."




