

# Bulletin Announcement Regarding Security (page 1: English / page 2: Spanish)

We wanted to take a moment to discuss safety and the possibility of protesters, disrupters, or a violent incident at the church. As you all have heard, there has been an escalation of violence in our communities. With the impending release of the United States Supreme Court decision that could overturn or limit Roe v. Wade, we thought it prudent to discuss these topics in an abundance of caution. Most likely nothing like this will happen here or anywhere.

When you come to mass, please be aware of your surroundings and if you see something strange that makes you uncomfortable, say something to one of the ushers, ministers of hospitality, Eucharistic ministers, or the presider.

If there is an emergency and we need to evacuate the church, we ask that you leave calmly through one of the exits.

If protesters or disrupters come to the church, please do not engage with them. Please allow the police to take care of this. If you feel unsafe and are unsure if the police have been called, please call 9-1-1. If you feel unsafe, it is acceptable to leave mass.

If there is an outbreak of violence, please use these steps to protect yourself:

<u>RUN</u>: if there is violence, evacuate and get as far away from the danger as possible. The parish has established the field as a safe area. If you can, run there or run to any place of safety. Leave your personal belongings behind. Assist others to leave with you. Call 9-1-1 when safe to do so.

<u>HIDE</u>: if you cannot run because the violence is too close or your exit is blocked, <u>hide</u>. The best place to hide is somewhere where you can barricade yourself inside like a room or a closet. Lock the door and pile furniture in front of the door. If you cannot hide inside a room, lie flat on the floor, try to cover yourself with something and remain silent. Spread out and stay out of view. Try to silence your cell phone.

<u>FIGHT</u>: if there is no other option, <u>fight</u>. Throw things or use an improvised weapon from anything near you including sacred objects such as the processional cross, a statue, or candlesticks. Act as aggressively as possible by yelling and throwing things.

Deseamos tomar un momento para comentar el tema de la seguridad y la posibilidad de manifestantes, perturbadores o un incidente violento en la iglesia. Como todos ustedes han escuchado, ha habido una escalada de violencia en nuestras comunidades. Con la publicación inminente de la decisión de la Corte Suprema de los Estados Unidos que podría revocar o limitar Roe v. Wade, pensamos que es prudente discutir estos temas con mucha precaución. Lo más probable es que nada de esto suceda aquí, ni en ninguna parte.

Cuando venga a Misa, esté atento a su entorno y si ve algo extraño que lo incomode, dígaselo a uno de los ujieres, ministros de hospitalidad, ministros de la Eucaristía o la persona que preside.

Si hay una emergencia y necesitamos evacuar la iglesia, le pedimos que salga con calma por una de las salidas.

Si los manifestantes o perturbadores vienen a la iglesia, no se involucre con ellos. Por favor, permita que la policía se encargue de esto. Si se siente inseguro y no está seguro de si llamaron a la policía, llame al 9-1-1. Si se siente inseguro, es aceptable dejar la Misa.

Si hay un brote de violencia, siga estos pasos para protegerse:

<u>CORRER</u>: si hay violencia, evacuar y alejarse lo más posible del peligro. La parroquia ha establecido el campo como un área segura. Si puede, corra allí o corra a cualquier lugar seguro. Deje atrás sus pertenencias personales. Ayude a otros a irse con usted. Llame al 9-1-1 cuando sea seguro hacerlo.

<u>ESCONDER</u>: si no puedes correr porque la violencia está demasiado cerca o tu salida está bloqueada, <u>escóndete</u>. El mejor lugar para esconderse es un lugar donde pueda atrincherarse dentro, como una habitación o un armario. Cierre la puerta y apile los muebles frente a la puerta. Si no puede esconderse dentro de una habitación, acuéstese en el piso, intente cubrirse con algo y permanezca en silencio. Espárzase y manténgase fuera de la vista. Trate de silenciar su teléfono celular.

<u>LUCHAR</u>: si no hay otra opción, <u>lucha</u>. Tira cosas o usa un arma improvisada desde cualquier lugar cercano a ti, incluidos objetos sagrados como la cruz procesional, una estatua o candelabros. Actúe de la forma más agresiva posible gritando y tirando cosas.


### S.E.A.S. PARISH UPDATE ANNUAL MINISTRIES APPEAL 2022

# **ADORATION CHAPEL Q & A SERIES #62**

**Q**: Is there a connection between our celebration of The Body and Blood of Christ and Eucharistic Adoration?

A. Yes. We are celebrating, loving, and adoring Jesus in the Eucharist.

From an article from Aleteia, (6/16/2022, Aleteia.org): It is also called "**Corpus Domini**," which similarly means "Body of the Lord."

The official name in English is, "The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ."

This name more accurately summarizes the entire mystery of the Eucharist, as it includes Jesus' body and blood.

Currently, the feast has been moved in many places to the **Sunday following Trinity Sunday** to make it possible for more of the faithful to participate in the Mass of Corpus Christi.

We are called to worship and revere Jesus in the Eucharist. The Eucharistic host is not a symbol of Jesus, it is really him: his body and blood.
