PRAYER OF POPE FRANCIS TO MARY, HEALTH OF THE SICK

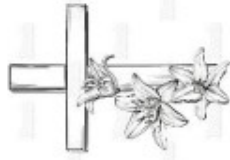
O Mary, you shine continuously on our journey as a sign of salvation and hope.

Amen.

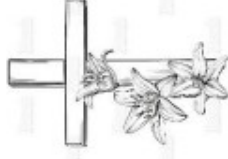

S.E.A.S. PARISH UPDATE ANNUAL MINISTRIES APPEAL 2022

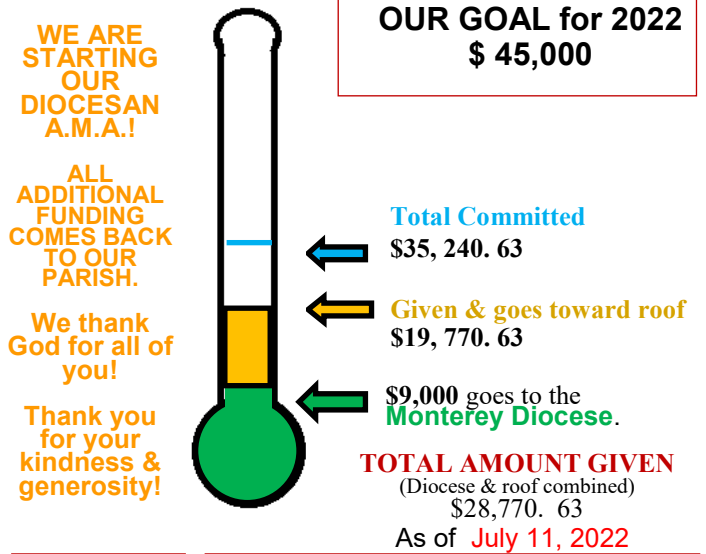

Then, on August 14, Bishop Danny Garcia will be here for the Confirmation Mass and will also bless the Adoration Chapel, allowing us to use it.

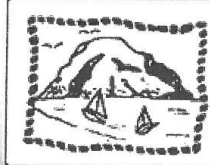
