As a child, sometimes in Catholic schools, there would be a project that children were asked to do. They fold paper in such a way so that when cutting out a person, it looks like there are several people holding hands as they stand next to each other. Often, the craft was used as a reminder to children to love one another.

Loving one another is intrinsic. We are loved by parents, both natural and adopted. We are loved by our friends, our brothers, sisters, children. Why then, do we need to be taught to love one another?

God had given many laws to the Jewish people. They are recorded in the Torah, which for us are the first five books of the Bible. The Sadducees and Pharisees who were the religious leaders at Jesus' time had the responsibility for ensuring the Jewish people followed those laws in order to be faithful to the covenant that had been made with God. When Jesus came to the temple area of Jerusalem and threw over the tables the next day, according to the Gospel of Matthew (chapters 21 and 22) he began preaching to the people using parables. The Pharisees and Sadducees asked him by whose authority he was doing all this and they questioned what he was saying to discern that. They asked him which law or commandment was the greatest of all. Jesus responded, "'You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the greatest and the first commandment. The second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself.'" Mt 22: 37-39

God is first above all things. Our lives should have God at its center.

Jesus has a point to make. Even though the Jews went to the temple for worship on Shabbat, their holy day, which is equivalent to our Sunday, that does not mean that God is the center of their lives. It means simply that they attend the liturgical service. Perhaps some of the Sadducees, Pharisees and people of Jesus' time were simply going to the worship service because they had been raised to do so and not going was against the cultural norm. Maybe some went to see their friends and to show off new clothes, prosperity, or to use it as a time to gossip. Jesus indirectly

called on them to search their hearts and see if they were truly at the temple because of their love for God. It is not enough to love God. Just as a teenager falls in love easily and loves someone, we would argue real love endures even hardships and has compassion, understanding, and mercy. This love we have cannot be a passing thing, but is felt deep within us and is resilient to the world around us. We must love God with our soul. We have to allow that innate part of ourselves where God, our creator, lives, allow us to be still and know that He is there. In like manner, when we love God with our minds, we choose to hold him in high esteem and give Him the love and reverence with which he is due. Moreover, when we love God with our mind, the more we are drawn to worship and adore.

When Jesus says we are to love our neighbor as ourselves, he knows that we are broken and do not always give ourselves or others the respect and love that we should. We are invited to love ourselves the way that God loves us through acknowledging that our Lord God makes us, each and every one of us perfect and in His own image, with the ability to love, to show mercy, and to forgive. We have to love each other and ourselves the way God loves us. We are being held not to our standards, but to God's. He has raised the bar for us, asking us to dig deep, knowing we are capable of this.

So, why are there wars? Why are there fights among family members? Why do we alienate others from our lives? Why do we ignore people sleeping overnight in the bushes along the street? Why do we ignore the telephone when the lonely person in our lives keeps calling?

It is true that we love within the relationships we have forged within the intimacy of our family and friend groups, but would you give a stranger a hug? Would you help the beggar in the local grocery store parking lot? Would you help in church ministries to feed the poor? Would you correct someone causing themselves harm? Would you share in Faith ministries to help others know how much God loves you and them? Would you step in to help a friend in financial trouble? Would you mentor a young family who hasn't support? Yes, God loves you. 'coz we love, we give.

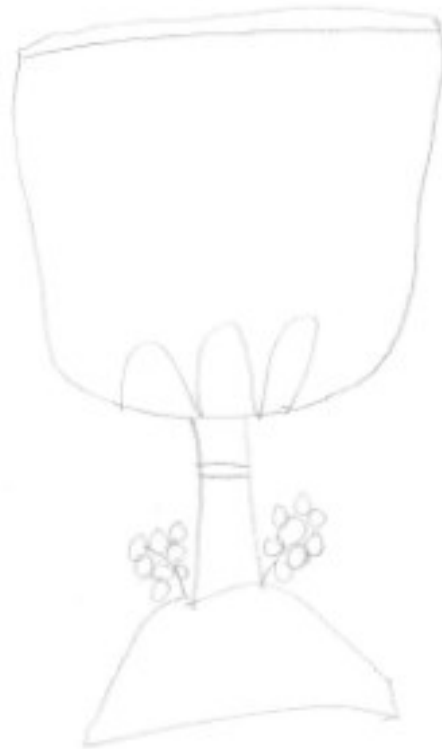

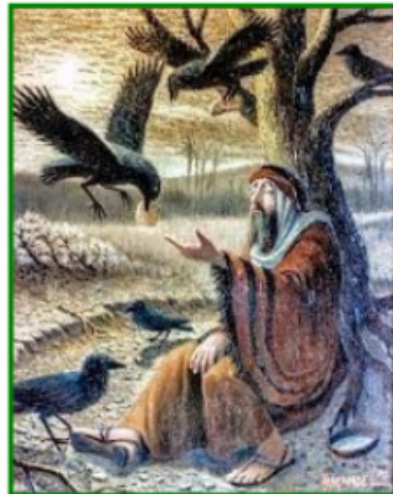

## FUNERAL MASS OF ANDRES RANCHES; ABOUT FUNERALS

A Funeral Mass for former parishioner Andres Ranches was held on Friday, October 27th.

There is a general misconception that Funeral or Memorial Masses are not important. This is not true.

The US Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB.org) reminds us, *"Because of our belief not only in the immortality of the soul, but also in the resurrection of the body, the Church professes hope in the face of death, and acts with charity in the funeral rites. The Church provides a number of prayers for the faithful to offer both to accompany the dying of a loved one and to strengthen our faith upon their death. Through private prayer and public funeral rites, we strengthen our faith and hope, comfort those who mourn, and bury the bodily remains of the deceased with care befitting what was the Temple of the Holy Spirit."*

Our Church canon law, Canon 1176 states that, "Deceased members of the Christian faithful must be given ecclesiastical funerals according to the norm of

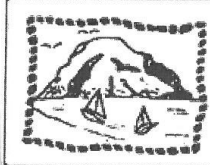
law." This include includes all the Baptized and also 1) Catechumens, 2) children whom parents intended to baptize but died before Baptism, and 3) "In the prudent judgment of the local ordinary, ecclesiastical funerals can be granted to baptized persons who are enrolled in a non-Catholic Church or ecclesial community unless their intention is evidently to the contrary and provided that their own minister is not available" (Canon 1183.3)

The Funeral Mass doesn't end at the church. The liturgy actually continues to the gravesite for the final commendation. This continuation is the final act of the community of faith caring for the beloved deceased. The liturgy where the body or ashes are to be laid in their final resting place is an act of Faith that the beloved departed will rise again through the glory of the resurrection. This Rite of Committal firmly reminds us that the Church on earth is in communion with the Church in Heaven. We are all one Church with Christ as our head. To bury the dead is also an act of charity.
