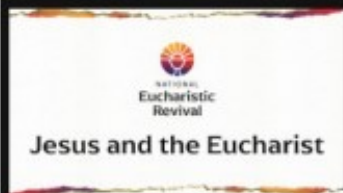

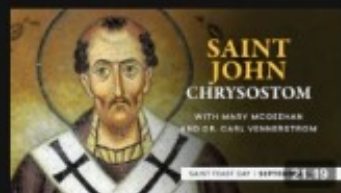

St Therese of Lisieux once said, *“Miss no single opportunity of making some small sacrifice, here by a smiling look, there by a kindly word; always doing the smallest right and doing it all for love.”*

It is amazing the depth of God’s mercy and charity through a single act of kindness. Taught by the traditions through our families and Holy Mother Church we offer charity; to be Jesus to others. We give from what we have, but not diminish from ourselves, but united with Christ. In 1971 an Australian philosopher, Peter Singer wrote an article, *“Famine, Affluence, and Morality,”* originally inspired by the starvation of Bangladesh Liberation War refugees and the lack of aide. In his article he offered an analogy of a child drowning in a pond. That child represented in general all persons in need of help, of love. What if it is a small smile, or a kindly word that encourages and can save that child? What if it is a hand held out is all they need? The pond represents the world just like in Scripture the ‘vineyard’ is often an allegory for the world. Just as we are compelled to help the drowning child, so too should we be compelled to help others in need and if not directly, then to offer assistance through other means.

It is not always easy though to give of ourselves share in Christ’s ministry in the vineyard world. What Saint has ever gone through life without struggle or grief? Our Catholic Church is full of martyrs, full of Saints who have been tried and tested, and yet still follow Christ. This is what we are called to do as well. God so loves us, his children. The love of Christ gathers us into one. God is love, and all who live in love abide in God and God abides in them.

In the Gospel of Matthew (Mt 21:28-32) we encounter an allegory or parable of two sons whom the father sends to world in the vineyard. One says no, but then has a change of heart. The other says yes, but then does not go.

Which are we? Are we like the second son? Reflect. When was the last time someone asked you for help and you said yes, but then failed to follow through because it was inconvenient to you or you just did not want to do it? How much hurt and anguish does that cause the other person, yourself, and those around you?

Maybe we are like the second son. We don’t know his story fully. Maybe he had different priorities like his own family, or work, or travel plans, or a date, or anything else. And yet he took the time to reflect and realize that his father needed help and was telling him to go into the field not because it was a whim, but because it was necessary. The son reconfigures his will, his heart, to be one with his father’s just as we reconfigure our hearts and our wills to be more like that of our heavenly Father when we offer his love and mercy even through the smallest act of kindness like a smile, or sacrifice like a pebble in our shoe to remember to pray for those who do not have any, or listening to someone speak about their loved one who has recently died. There are so many ways to share our Father’s love and mercy.

The image of Divine Mercy with the rays of love and mercy coming from Jesus’ Sacred Heart remind us that these graces flow without ceasing and flow like an ocean of mercy to all as he steps toward us. God moves toward us to give us his mercy and love. Holy Mother Church teaches that Christ is our King. *“He is said to reign “in the hearts of men,” both by reason of the keenness of his intellect and the extent of his knowledge, and also because he is very truth, and it is from him that truth must be obediently received by all mankind. He reigns, too, in the wills of men, for in him the human will was perfectly and entirely obedient to the Holy Will of God, and further by his grace and inspiration he so subjects our free-will as to incite us to the most noble endeavors. He is King of hearts, too, by reason of his “charity which exceedeth all knowledge.” And his mercy and kindness which draw all men to him, for never has it been known, nor will it ever be, that man be loved so much and so universally as Jesus Christ.”* (QUAS PRIMAS. Pope Pius XI, 1925)

It is Christ’s love that we imitate when we share in works of mercy at our parishes, within our Diocese, within our neighborhoods, throughout the world. Maybe from the love we have in our hearts, all we can give is the work of our hands, maybe it is money. Both are valid coming from love. ‘coz we love, we give.
