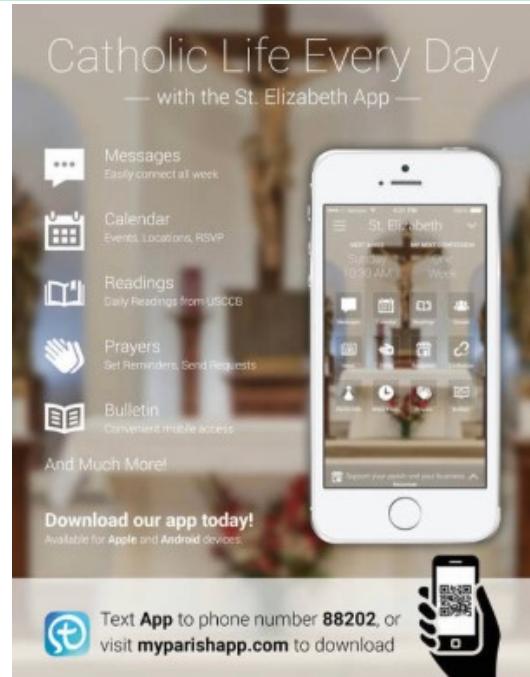

There is a children's game called, *Musical Chairs*. It begins with several chairs set in a circle, one for each child with their backs facing each other. At the very onset of the game, one chair is taken away. Music is played and the children walk around this circle of chairs. When the music stops, the children rush to sit on a chair before the others. No one wants to be the person left without a chair because that person is then 'out' and can only watch the next round. The game continues in this fashion until only one chair is left and the person sitting on it is declared the winner.

In Mt 23:1-12 we hear Jesus speaking about how the "scribes and pharisees have taken their seat on the chair of Moses." They were serving as judges of the law while enjoying their parties and popularity, not necessarily following the law or serving those around them the way they ought. In a sense, they were playing *Musical Chairs*, trying their best to sit in it before the music stopped, hoping no one would take away their authority or show them the truth. In our more modern era, perhaps we see this playing out in various arenas of our lives, from politics to work to TikTok to YouTube, as others seem to be in a perpetual quest for influence, popularity, and authority. Everyone wants to have a bit of authority and their fifteen minutes of fame. What is the cost though? Is it truly worth going after that fame and 'glory' if it is fleeting? Is it worth the pain that it can cause others?

What does Jesus remind the scribes and pharisees? What does he remind us? The things of the world are fleeting.

*Carpe diem*, which is translated as 'seize the day,' is popular in our consumer cultural society plagued with war and strife. Some believe *carpe diem* means they should do what they want while seeking hedonistic pleasures without regarding the damage they cause themselves or others. *The Great Gatsby* by F. Scott Fitzgerald emphasized this with Jay Gatsby's character who treats others, especially women as objects, most specifically Daisy, the woman he sought as part of what he envisioned for making his life perfect, taking what he wanted and leaving behind cha-

os as he pursued this 'American Dream.' How much this book from 1925 has influenced American culture! How it drives this idea of the 'American Dream' and permeates our culture! Is there any question why, in certain segments of society, God has been 'thrown out the window?'

The Roman poet, Horace, originally used *carpe diem* in his Odes. He did not use it in the sense that it is translated and used today. No. In the Latin and English translations offered by Cooney Classics (Horace. *Odes*. Cooney Classics, last accessed Nov. 2023 from [Carpe Diem: Odes 1:11 - Horace — COONEYCLASSICS](#), ) Leuconoe is the person to whom Horace writes advising her to not worry about things that could happen in the future, but to consider who she is now and the gifts and time that are present so as to truly appreciate them, and to trust in tomorrow. Perhaps this makes you think of Mary and Martha? "Martha, Martha," the Lord answered, "you are worried and upset about many things, but few things are needed—or indeed only one." (Lk 10:41-42)

"Have faith in God." Jesus says. (Mk 11:22)

St Paul reminds us that we are given this Faith through our baptisms, "I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me." (Gal 2:20)

Time is fleeting, but we CAN cherish the gift of the world that God has given us and live a life of faith by seeking to do his will by joining in Christ's work for our salvation. Seek the greatest gift of all! Each of us are brothers and sisters in Christ. As such, we are called to love, and the gifts we have, we are given to share.

The very act of coming to celebrate Mass together, that is, in faith and trust, we choose to bring ourselves with all our burdens and worries, to the church. When we enter, we make the sign of the cross and reverence the Lord. We are his holy people. We are his children. We are one people. God is our Father. Christ is our Master. He leads us wherever we go. He leads us in the Way, the Truth, and the Life. He teaches us love, true caritas. For where love is, God is there. God loves you. 'coz we love, we give.

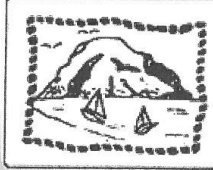
