Holy Mother Church celebrates World Day of the Poor on the weekend of November 19th this year. In his message to the world on the occasion of the seventh anniversary of this special day in the Church calendar, Pope Francis hopes “it enables us to discover ever anew the heart of the Gospel.” He also quotes from the Book of Tobit 4: 7: “Do not turn your face away from anyone who is poor.”

Within the Book of Tobit we discover a family, a father specifically who is teaching and leading his family not only in the habit of prayer, but also in charitable acts. The son, Tobias, is going on a long journey. Meanwhile Tobit is uncertain if he will ever see his son again, so he is leaving him a spiritual guidebook for life, which he hopes will give his son help in staying the course in continuing to love and serve God, something Tobit has always taught his son in word and deed, and hopes his son will continue living. The narrative describes Tobit’s deportation and that of the many who were taken into captivity by the Assyrians. It shares how Tobit remained faithful to God in diet, prayer, and good works, and how he was punished by the king for it. It talks about how Tobit also became blind and a social outcast. Nonetheless, Tobit never left God’s company. He hopes that his own words will give his son strength and comfort in the difficulties of life. Out of his very little, Tobit never gave up his charitable offerings to those in need. He encourages his son, all of us too, to do what is right and help anyone who is poor. These lessons serve Tobias well and even benefit Tobit, for when we help those in need, Tobias discovered, we are serving God.

Pope Francis takes special note of that phrase, ‘anyone who is poor,’ and he writes, *“Everyone is our neighbour. Regardless of the colour of their skin, their social standing, the place from which they came, if I myself am poor, I can recognize my brothers or sisters in need of my help. We are called to acknowledge every poor person and every form of poverty, abandoning the indifference and the banal excuses we make to protect our illusory well-being.”*

In the Gospel of Matthew, chapter five, Jesus shares with us the Beatitudes, a Way of life. In Mt 5:3, we hear, “Blessed are the poor in spirit...” What does that mean?

How does that connect with Tobit and giving charitably through our love for God? At first we may think that the poor in spirit are those who are sad and suffering. One translation, *New Living Translation*, of that Beatitude leads us close to the meaning: “God blesses those who are poor and realize their need for Him, for the Kingdom of Heaven is theirs.” This is a lesson in humility. It is a realization that we ought to have that without God, we are all poor in spirit and we need him. It is very different from the world around us that teaches us to be self-sufficient and independent. It is that call to relationship with God the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. It is that call to share in Christ’s work and be the face of God for others because he dwells within us.

As we celebrate Thanksgiving, let us recall why it was originally celebrated. It was not due to politics or the power of nations, but out of true thanksgiving, placing a heartfelt gratefulness towards the Creator who provides for us with limitless love and charity. We give thanks to the Lord our God. Liturgically, we are ending the Church year with the culmination at the Solemnity of Christ the King, Lord of the Universe. That is who should be at the center of our hearts and lives. That is not an easy task. We need more Tobits to teach the younger generations how to keep God at the center of our lives and to exercise that faith through acts of charity.

The USCCB reminds us that Jesus said, “I give you a new commandment: love one another. . . . This is how all will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another” (Jn 13:34). With these words, the entire Christian vocation is conveyed in a simple, profound definition of charity. The “new commandment” of charity unites love of God with love of neighbor; it bridges Old and New Testaments; it provides the foundation for human morality; it spans all time and all peoples. (*In All Things Charity: A Pastoral Challenge for the New Millennium | USCCB* )

As God gives us, so too must we give. We have ample opportunities. We can feed the hungry, clothe the naked. We can help our parishes financially, so they continue to help us grow spiritually. Together we can do amazing things in Christ’s love. ‘coz we love, we give.

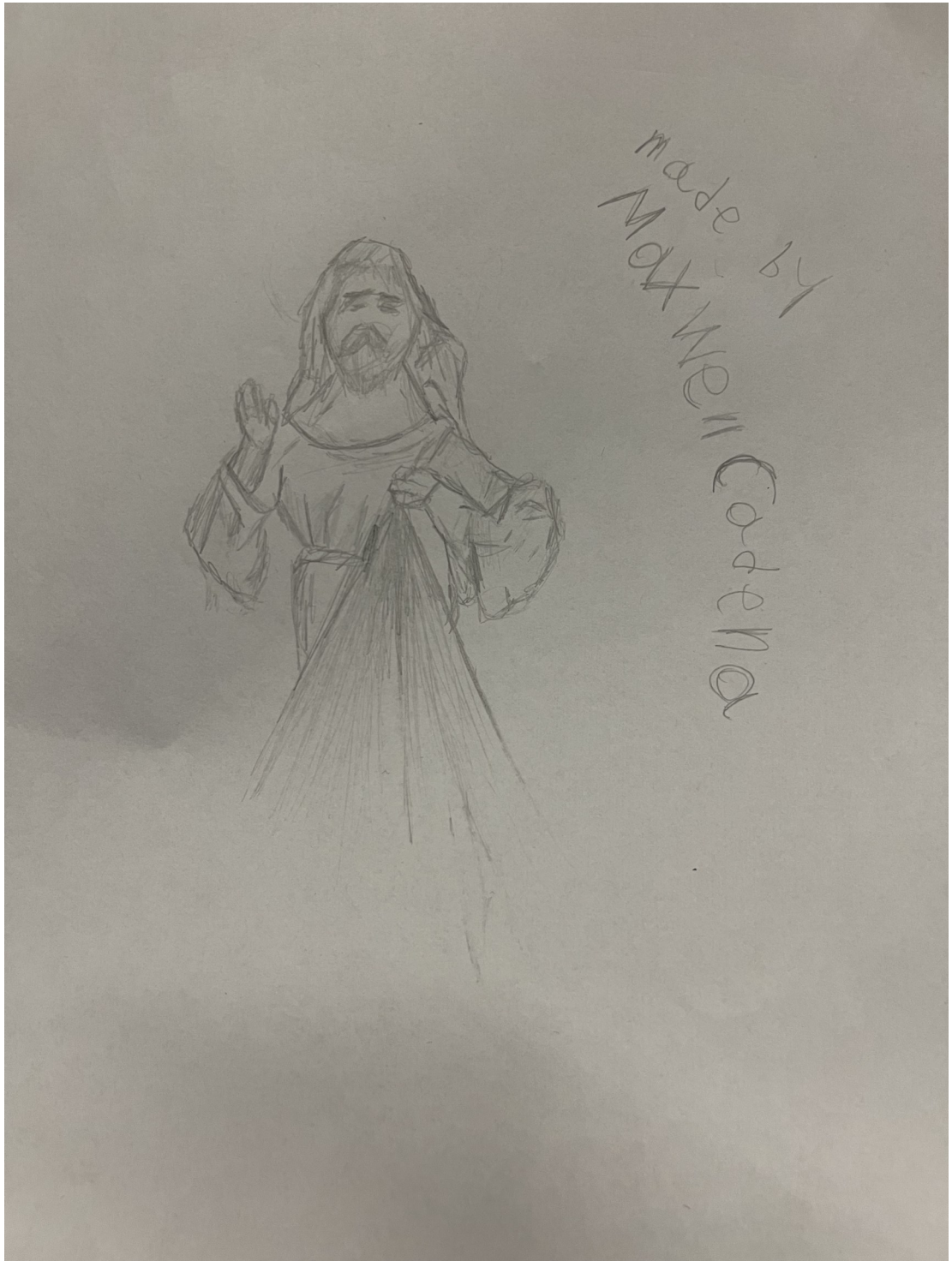

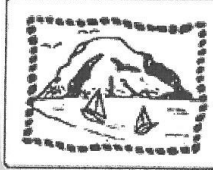
